## Lecture Hours-to-Units

0.5 lecture hours = 0.5 unit

1.0 lecture hours = 1.0 unit

1.5 lecture hours = 1.5 units

2.0 lecture hours = 2.0 units

2.5 lecture hours = 2.5 units

3.0 lecture hours = 3.0 units

## Lab Hours-to-Units

1.5; 2.0; 2.5 lab hours = 0.5 unit

3.0; 3.5; 4.0 lab hours = 1.0 unit

4.5; 5.0; 5.5 lab hours = 1.5 units

6.0; 6.5; 7.0 lab hours = 2.0 units

7.5; 8.0; 8.5 lab hours = 2.5 units

9.0; 9.5; 10.0 lab hours = 3.0 units

10.5; 11.0; 11.5 lab hours = 3.5 units

12.0; 12.5; 13.0 lab hours = 4.0 units

13.5; 14.0; 14.5 lab hours = 4.5 units

15.0; 15.5; 16.0 lab hours = 5.0 units

16.5; 17.0; 17.5 lab hours = 5.5 units

18.0; 18.5; 19.00 lab hours = 6.0 units

\* The above calculations do NOT apply to Work Experience courses. Work Experience units are awarded based on student on-the-job-training hours: (75 paid hours or 60 unpaid hours = one semester unit).
