Summer 2024 Paid Internship

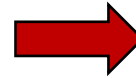
Open to all STEM Southwestern College students

NIWC internship focuses on interdisciplinary projects in various STEM fields. Interns will receive hands-on experience as members of a research group, carrying out fundamental work in areas pertaining to NIWC Pacific.

- Applicants must be available for the entire period of the internship (June 3 to August 1, 2024) and able to work 15 to 20 hours per week.
- Internship will be conducted in-person and/or hybrid.
- Register in PD 290 in summer 2024.
- \$5,000 internship stipend.

Complete the [Google form application](#) by attaching your current résumé, Student Education Plan (SEP) dated within one year, and all unofficial college transcripts.

Eligibility Criteria:

Applicants may be majoring in any of the following:

- Astronomy
- Biology
- Chemistry/Biochemistry
- Geography
- Geology
- Math/Computer Science
- Engineering
- Physics

Other Eligibility Criteria:

- Completed some college level Math and Physics (Math 250 and Physics 270 preferred)
- Plans to transfer to a four-year institution from SWC (does not need to have applied yet)
- 3.0 or above GPA preferred
- **U.S. Citizenship required (Not eligible if you claim dual citizenship)**
