1. Preview Requests T. Axsom
Please remember to route all requests to preview instructional computer software or audiovisual materials through the Library regardless of how you find the information (direct advertising, company representative, or the Internet). The Library Support Services supervisor will place the order with the company and notify you when the materials arrive on campus. Your cooperation with this procedure allows tracking of what is on campus and can save time and trouble for both college staff and producer's staff.

1. Academic Success Center (ASC) Building 420 T. Axsom
The Academic Success Center tutors are located in Building 420. Office hours to schedule tutorial appointments, group sessions, and study groups are Mon -Thu 8:00 am - 8:00 pm and Fri 8:00 am - 4:00 pm. Tutoring sessions last 50 minutes and are available for most disciplines. We also offer walk-in assistance. ASC tutors use a variety of instructional approaches appropriate for different skill levels and learning styles. To enable students to become efficient and independent learners, the ASC helps them master course material and apply effective study strategies. The Center serves the college by helping under-prepared students prepare, prepared students advance, and advanced students excel. Students are encouraged to take advantage of tutoring services early each semester in order to maximize their full learning potential. 1. T3 Program (Tutors, Tweens, and Teens) T. Axsom
The T3 Program (Tutors, Tweens, and Teens) is a tutoring program for students in grades 5 through 12 and is offered through Continuing Education and Academic Success Center. Tutoring appointments are individual, one-to-one, 55-minute sessions. Two-hour sessions are available for grades 7-12, if appropriate. Time is allotted at the end of each session for tutee-tutor goal-setting for future sessions and the tutor's completion of Tutor Diaries and the T3 Appointment Confirmation Forms. 3. Blood and Bone Marrow Drive A. Ricasa
Our next drive is scheduled to take place on Thu, Feb 19, from 9:00 am-2:30 pm in the Bloodmobile parked behind Trade Winds Coffee Shop. Schedule an appointment to donate today! Before your appointment please drink plenty of fluids, eat a good meal and bring a picture ID. The bone marrow screening is done by a simple cheek swab. 4. Blood Testing Available A. Ricasa
Health Services can provide a breakdown of cholesterol counts (lipid profile)—HDL, LDL, and triglycerides, as well as offering glucose and hemoglobin levels. Prices are \$16 for glucose, hemoglobin, and lipid profile; \$15 for glucose and lipid profile only; and \$3 for hemoglobin. Fasting is recommended. For information, contact Health Services.
5. Free Pregnancy Testing A. Ricasa

6. Hepatitis B Vaccination Program A. Ricasa
