1. Preview Requests T. Axsom

1. Writing Center Tutoring T. Axsom
The Writing Center offers free tutoring for students seeking help with their written assignments, resumes, cover letters, scholarship essays, etc. Writing Center tutors are trained and experienced and can help students improve their English writing skills while working on assignments for any class. From brainstorming to writing conclusions, from essays to research papers, from grammar rules to citation rules, from personal statements and scholarship essays to cover letters and resumes, we have help for you. The Writing Center is located in the ASC (Rm 420-D) and hours are as follows: Mon-Thu 9:00 am-5:30 pm Fri 9:00 am-1:00 pm Sat & Sun Closed

2. Academic Success Center (ASC) Building 420 T. Axsom
 The Academic Success Center tutors are located in Rm 420. Office hours to schedule tutorial appointments, group sessions, and study groups are Mon -Thu 8:00 am - 8:00 pm and Fri 8:00 am - 4:00 pm. Tutoring sessions last 50 minutes and are available for most disciplines. We also offer walk-in assistance. ASC tutors use a variety of instructional approaches appropriate for different skill levels and learning styles. To enable students to become efficient and independent learners, the ASC helps them master course material and apply effective study strategies. The Center serves the college by helping under-prepared students prepare, prepared students advance, and advanced students excel. Students are encouraged to take advantage of tutoring services early each semester in order to maximize their full learning potential. 3. Writing Center Writing Workshops T. Axsom

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. T3 Program Tutors, Tweens, and Teens T. Axsom
 The T3 Program Tutors, Tweens, and Teens is a tutoring program for students in grades 5 through 12 and is offered through Continuing Education and Academic Success Center. Tutoring appointments are individual, one-to-one, 55-minutes sessions in Rm 420. Two-hour sessions are available for grades 7-12, if appropriate. Time is allotted at the end of each session for tutee-tutor goal-setting for future sessions and the tutor's completion of Tutor Diaries and the T3 Appointment Confirmation Forms.
