

Academic Senate Plan for SLO Reorganization

The Academic Senate has reviewed the model utilized at Long Beach City College and has decided to adopt SLOs under Academic Senate purview as an academic and professional matter.

The model in LBCC calls for the following:

- **Two faculty coordinators:** one for CTE programs and one for Academic Programs (compensation to be determined by the SCEA)
- **Approximately 25 Point People:** one faculty member for each Dept. (compensation to be determined by the SCEA)
- The establishment of **Learning Outcomes and Assessment Review Committee (LOARC)**, which as part of the Senate will be chaired by the two faculty coordinators and the Director of Institutional Planning and Grants. LOARC will discuss, review and provide recommendations to the SCC to provide institutional guidance in shared planning and decision-making and prioritization needs as well as institutional processes.

This proposal is to bring into reality this plan by January 2017.
