SLO Liaison Position

The SLO Liaisons are faculty leaders and are responsible for managing the SLO assessment processes for courses and programs. An SLO Liaison informs discipline faculty on updates to the outcomes assessment process, assists in the maintenance of timelines, and supports faculty in various stages of course and programmatic outcomes assessment. SLO Liaisons perform detail-oriented tasks involving SLO organization via computer and internet technologies including the use of eLumen and CurricUNET.

By signing this document both parties agree that the MOU dated April 26, 2017 concerning SLO Point positions will be nullified and replaced by this MOU.

Responsibilities:

- 1. Advising faculty on the creation and modification of SLOs as needed
- 2. Advising faculty in the creation of rubrics and assessment tools for collecting SLO data
- 3. Advising faculty in the creation of Outcomes Assessment Timelines (OATs) and informing faculty of deadlines stated in OATs
- 4. Facilitating faculty input of SLO data into eLumen and storage of discussion notes
- 5. Coordinating faculty discussions on assessment data review, creation of action plans, and use of SLO assessment results in program review
- 6. Inputting and managing all approved new, modified, and inactivated SLOs into eLumen, as needed
- 7. Creating and distributing SLO packages to faculty as stated in OATs via eLumen each semester
- 8. Running eLumen reports for discipline faculty review
- 9. Facilitating workshops on SLO assessment as needed
- 10. Completing an annual survey that summarizes the past year's SLO assessment activities and accomplishments across the disciplines assigned
- 11. Maintain currency in SLO assessment practices
