Approve Agreement No. A5094.16 with MediFit Community Services, LLC, for the District's Wellness Center Management & Operation Services, for the period July 13, 2016 to July 12, 2021, inclusive, in the amount of \$10,416.66 per month adjusted annually to factor Consumer Price Index/U.S. City Average or 2% whichever is lower, for a total not to exceed amount of \$713,005 Base Management Fee for the five and a half year term of the contract plus Incentive Management Fee.

OVERVIEW

In December 2014, the District entered into an MOU with MediFit Community Services, LLC (MediFit) to provide time sensitive Scope 1 related services for Pre-construction: Design, Development and Procurement related services of the RFP.

The District has since negotiated the final Agreement with MediFit that encompasses all the aspects of Scope 2: Post–construction: Wellness Center Management and Operation Services and covers the following per the terms and conditions as defined in the RFP:

- MediFit will operate the Wellness Center, through District's branding, messaging, staffing, and collaboration.
- MediFit will operate the District's Wellness Center as a facility dedicated to recognizing the priorities of Academics, Community and Business stewardship. The Wellness Center will function as a "teaching health center" with opportunities for students, faculty and staff with industry career/professional expertise.
- MediFit will be investing in the Wellness Center's success by actively engaging in creating a community centered high value operation to members currently unserved within the South Bay community at comparable market rates.
- The following financial terms have been negotiated in this contract:

Summary of Compensation Structure

 Base Management Fee \$10,415 Per Month adjusted annually at the beginning of each anniversary date to factor the Consumer Price Index/U.S. City Average increase or 2%, whichever is lower, for a total not to exceed amount of \$713,005 through the term of the agreement.

- Incentive of 30% of Positive Variance to Budget or 20% of Net Operating Income (NOI) for Pre-Sale and Year 1.
- Incentive of 18% of NOI capped at \$275,000 for years 2 and 3.
- Incentive of 20% of NOI capped at \$275,000 for years 4 and 5.

- The pre-opening plan includes activities to market/pre-sale memberships, hire professional staff, train all staff, develop manuals and emergency procedures, and prepare for opening. The budgeted pre-opening expenses are estimated at \$350,000 which the District has to fund to support the successful start of this operation.
- In addition, the District will have to factor and fund the Year 1 projected loss of \$245,000.
