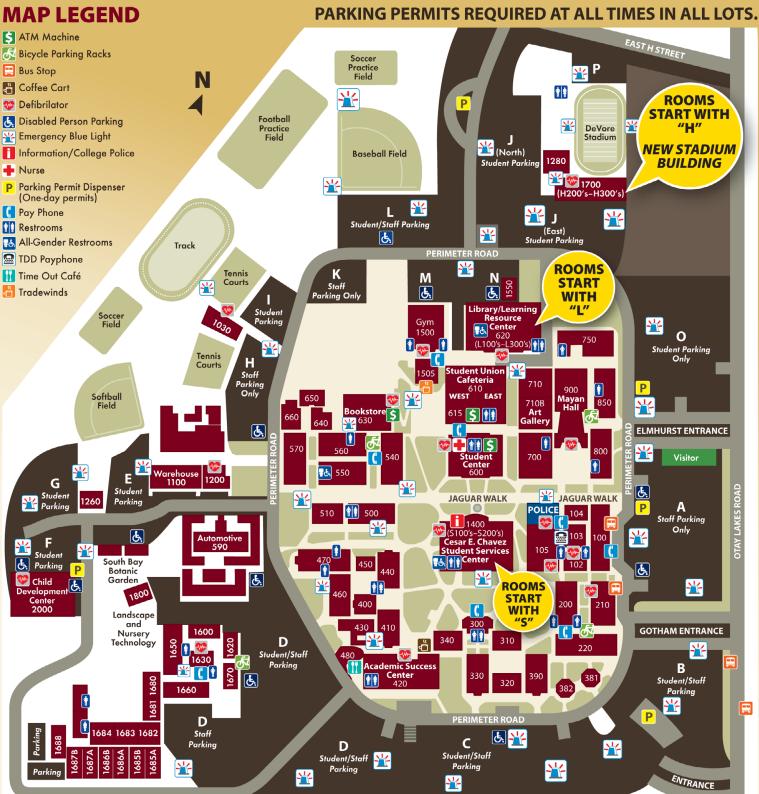

Explain why this project is needed:

This project constructs a new Fitness/Wellness Center and Gymnasium that will be relocated and consolidates a majority of Exercise Science functions. This project will include the replacement of the old gymnasium (1965 building) and the replacement of related physical education buildings. The existing facility is aging, in need of significant repair and can no longer accomodate the growth in these programs. The existing gymnasium is land-locked and has no direct access to nearby fields which restricts program delivery. Construction will include a new 50 meter multiple use pool supporting the aquatics programs. The old gymnasium and related sports structures will be demolished as a secondary effect in site preparation for the MSE building. The new facility is planned for 37,800 ASF.

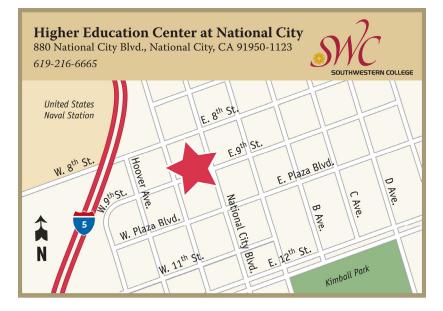

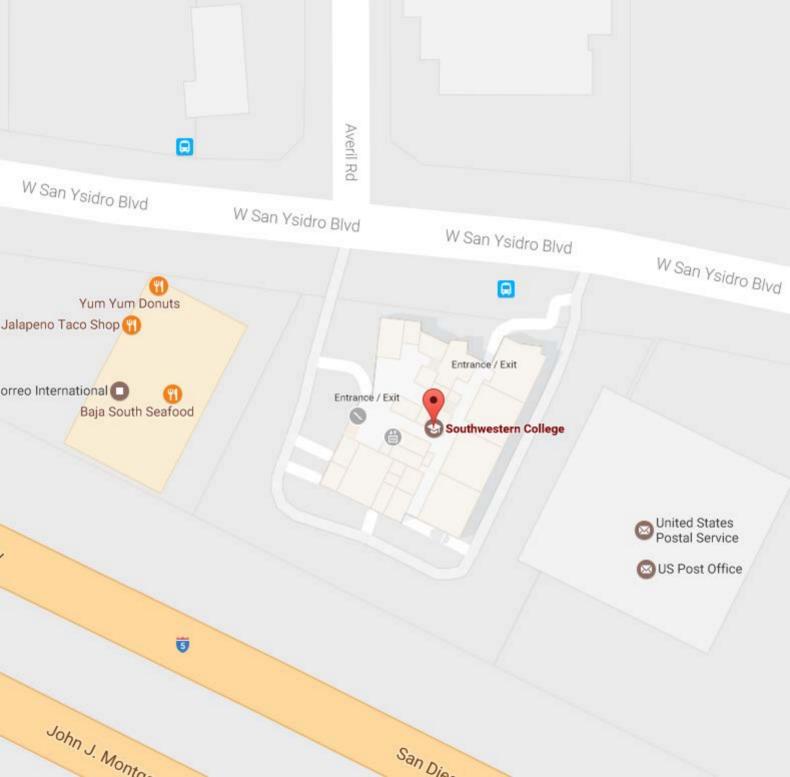
