## Teaching with Technology Track

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### VoiceThread: Initial Training & Setup

VoiceThread lets you create engaging discussions using a mix of audio, video, and text. Discussions can be centered around images, PowerPoint slides, or even videos, and participants can use digital pencils to annotate as well. We will experience its power from the student perspective and then go into instructor mode to create a VoiceThread. You will learn how to ensure accessibility as well, including connecting your VoiceThreads to our captioning service for seamless captioning requests. **Participants who complete this training and setup session will be able to start using VoiceThread in their Fall 2018 Canvas courses.** To ensure accessibility, VoiceThread is only installed for trained instructors.

### Accessible Course Content: Key Practices

Learn about the major steps faculty can take to make materials accessible, including documents, Canvas pages, images, links, and videos. We will explore captioning options such as DIY captioning, 3C Media Solutions, and CaptionSync, a service that provides an interactive transcript, search tool, dictionary lookup, and other features useful for all students. By law, materials for online and hybrid courses must be accessible to all learners at the start of the course, and this workshop will teach you how. The last 30 minutes will be reserved for hands-on practice and help, so please bring your projects and questions.

# Making Videos with Camtasia

This workshop will teach participants how to use Camtasia to make instructional videos shine! Learn the secrets of successful screencasting and how to add arrows, highlighting, transitions, and other special effects. **You will even have a chance to go Hollywood and try using a green screen in SWC's NEW recording room!** We will cover planning, recording, editing, captioning, and producing videos to use in your classes, so bring your ideas and even your raw footage. Popular projects include welcome videos, course tours, how-to videos, and unit introductions. Laptops will be provided, but if you have a laptop with webcam, you are welcome to bring it and we can install Camtasia during this session. *Hurdle credit available.*

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### Canvas Basics 1 & 2

**Part 1:** Get to know Canvas! Customize your dashboard and notifications, take a tour of the navigation menus, and check out the Canvas Inbox and Calendar. **Part 2:** Try out announcements, discussions, and quizzes, and then learn about the many options for presenting content using Canvas pages, including using images and videos. Our last stop in this session will be a brief introduction to assignment grading.
