AB 1725 assigns a major role to the Academic Senate in the development of policies and procedures dealing with academic and professional matters. Applicable to SCC, the areas required for consultation are:

	<p>Faculty hires, Classified hires, Administrative hires, and Other unfunded needs.</p> <p>The college “off-cycle” this year as this process would typically take place in the fall semester in anticipation of budget development in the spring. However, the SCC did not want to wait a year to demonstrate to the Accreditation Commission that the process is clearly understood that planning and program review prioritization leads the budget process, so the process was accelerated to implement it this spring, providing for full budget development leadership. As Program Reviews and Snapshots will be due September 30, 2011, for the next round, prioritization will occur next fall and the college will be on regular planning cycle, demonstrating sustainability to the Commission.</p>
