AB 1725 Authority

AB 1725 assigns a major role to the Academic Senate in the development of policies and procedures dealing with academic and professional matters. Applicable to SCC, the areas required for consultation are:

Standards of policies regarding student preparation/success. 6. District and college governance structures, as related to faculty roles. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 7. Processes for institutional planning and budget development 8. Faculty roles and involvement in accreditation processes, including self-study and annual reports. 9. Policies for faculty professional development activities. 10. Processes for program review. + 1 Other academic and professional matters as mutually agreed between the Gov. Board & the Academic Senate.

The rationale is that students who have been attending the longest are able to register for the prerequisite courses to graduate. After a lengthy discussion M/S/C to approve the request.
