The **Student Outcomes Achievement and Review Committee (SOAR)** is a standing committee of the **Shared Consultation Council (SCC)**. It meets regularly to review institutional data and make recommendations to **SCC**.

SOAR was formerly known as the **ISLO** Committee and has worked for several years to develop our infrastructure for

collecting outcomes data in accordance with **ACCJC** guidelines. Listed below are **recommendations** available on SWC's [SLO website](#) regarding **SLOs**.

- All courses should have at least 4 Course-Level Student Learning Outcomes (CSLOs)
- All degree and certificate programs should have 3-4 Program-Level Student Learning Outcomes (PSLOs)
- All administrative units should have at least 3-4 Administrative Unit Outcomes (AUOs) or Student Affairs Outcomes (SAOs)
- All SLOs should be fully assessed by the time each discipline or unit completes a [Comprehensive Program Review](#)
