FAFSA applications for the 2015/2016 school year are still available. You MUST

apply on-line at www.fafsa.ed.gov. The Board of Governors Fee Waiver (BOGFW) application can help you pay for tuition fees. To find out if you qualify, you MUST apply on-line at www.swccd.edu. If you have already paid for your classes and

you qualify for BOGFW, you may also qualify for a reimbursement. All students must reapply every academic year. If you need assistance applying, please stop by the Financial Aid office in Student Services.

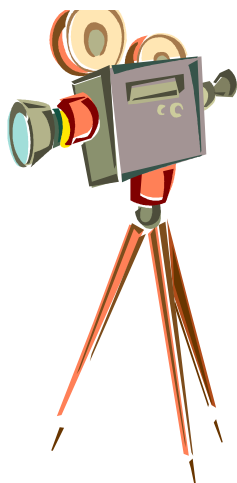
