ELECTION OF STUDENT TRUSTEE

Reference: Education Code Section 72023.5 and 72103

The A.S.O. Student Trustee will be elected by a plurality vote of currently enrolled students in the Spring A.S.O. election, and serve as Student Trustee for the next school year (June 1 through May 31, annually). All credit students of the student body are permitted to participate in the A.S.O. election. The election will be conducted in accordance with administrative procedures established by the Superintendent/President, or designee, and set forth in Article VII (Election Code) of the A.S.O. bylaws.

The Student Trustee may be recalled through an election conducted in the same manner as the election to office. A recall election will be called upon presentation of a petition signed by five percent (5%) of the A.S.O. members to the Superintendent/President pursuant to the A.S.O. constitution and bylaws. No recall election will be held if the petition is received within 90 days of a regularly scheduled election for student members.

If the seat of Student Trustee becomes vacant during his/her term by reason of resignation, recall, disqualification, or by any other reason, the Governing Board may authorize the officers of the A.S.O. established pursuant to Education Code Section 76060 to appoint a student to serve the remainder of the term in accordance with procedures established by the A.S.O. constitution and by-laws.

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
