DISPOSAL OF PROPERTY

Reference: Education Code Sections 70902(b)(6), 81360 81384 et seq., 81450 et seq.

U.S. Department of Education regulations on the Integrity of Federal Student Financial Aid Programs under Title IV of the Higher Education Act

of 1965, as amended.

The Governing Board has the authority under Education Code §81450 to §81460 to sell, auction, donate, or otherwise dispose of College District furniture, equipment, or materials that are unusable, obsolete, no longer needed, or unsuitable for College District use. The Governing Board may delegate to the Superintendent/President or her/his designee the authority to declare College District furniture, equipment, and various materials as surplus property upon determination that it is obsolete and unsuitable for College District use, and also to delegate the authority to dispose of surplus equipment and materials in accordance with current Education Code provisions.
