CONTRACTS – ELECTRONIC SYSTEMS AND MATERIALS

References: Education Code Sections 81641 et seq., and 81651; Public Contract Code Sections 20651 et seq.

The College District may contract with any vendor who has submitted one of the three lowest responsible competitive proposals or competitive bids for the purchase or maintenance of electronic data-processing systems and equipment, electronic telecommunication equipment, supporting software, and related material, goods and services.

Except as otherwise stated here, bids shall be solicited and contracts shall be awarded in accordance with Procedure No. 6330 AP - Purchasing, Bids and Contracts.

Criteria to determine what constitutes a responsive bid shall be established by the Director of Procurement, Central Services and Risk Management.

Supplemental instructional software packages may be purchased without taking estimates or advertising for bids.

Sale and leaseback of data-processing equipment or another major item of equipment is permissible if the purchaser agrees to lease the item back to the College District for use by the College District following the sale. The Governing Board shall first adopt a resolution finding that the sale or leaseback is the most economical means for providing electronic data-processing equipment or other major items of equipment to the College District.
