

SOUTHWESTERN COLLEGE STATE FIRE MARSHAL COURSE GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS



The information listed below is to help our students with general information and how to facilitate taking State Fire Marshal courses at our educational facility

Step One: Please email the instructor that you are interested in taking the desired State

Fire Marshal course. The instructor will give an email confirmation that they have received your request and that they have reserved a space for you.

Step Two: If you have never taken a course at Southwestern College and don't have an SWC

ID number, please go to www.swccd.edu or www.cccapply.org and fill out the SWC student application form. In 48 hours you will receive your SWC student ID number. If you already have a student ID number from previous classes or you're an enrolled a student now, then you do not need to apply to SWC for a new number. If you think you have a SWC ID number but don't know what it is, please call 619-216-6750, x4401 to have someone assist you in looking it up.

Step Three: Once you have received your ID number, please make a CASHIERS CHECK for the

correct monetary amount made payable to SWC with your student ID number in

the memo section. Mail the cashier's check and the registration form to:

instructor who will send the class syllabus and the required course textbook and

materials.
