Southwestern Community College District (SWC) administers their intercollegiate athletics programs in accordance with the rules and regulations adopted by the California Community College Athletic Association (CCCAA) and all applicable conferences. The CCCAA Constitution and Bylaws can be found on the Internet.

In addition to the student-athlete eligibility requirements found in the CCCAA Constitution and Bylaws, student athletes must observe SWC Standards of Conduct which are found in BP/AP 5700 Standards of Conduct.

The Athletic Director will conduct an annual in-service for all Athletic Department staff no later than the last Friday in August.

Each student-athlete meets annually with the Athletics Department staff to review applicable rules and policies.

Compliance

The Athletic Director annually completes the Statement of Compliance, Title IX Gender Equity (Form R4) and maintains the report in the Athletics Department.

At least once within every five (5) years, the CCCAA and the Pacific Coast Athletic Conference (PCAC) conducts a Program Review of each college's athletic department.

Every October the Athletic Director will complete and submit a mandatory Federal survey (the Equity in Athletics Disclosure Act of 1994) to the U.S. Department of Education.

The Athletic Director is delegated authority from the Vice President for Academic Affairs for developing, implementing, and monitoring the foregoing procedures.

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
