Initial EMT Checklist





Once you've completed your EMT course and successfully passed the National Registry exam, you will need to complete a Live Scan background check using the County of San Diego EMS Live Scan form. This form can be found on the County of San Diego EMS website.

Live Scans are performed all over the state but must be submitted from inside California.



Once you've completed the Live Scan, you will need to create an account in CoSD LEMSIS at <u>cosd.imagetrendlicense.com</u>. Please use Google Chrome or Firefox, as the platform does not translate well to Safari/Opera web browsers.

Here are the steps to become a certified California EMT:

Complete an EMT course and pass the NREMT exam
Live Scan completed in California
Create an account on <u>cosd.imagetrendlicense.com</u>
Select the EMT or AEMT Initial Application
Submit digital copies of the following documents:
 Professionally appropriate portrait-style photo for your LEMSIS ID
eCard (optional)
☐ Government-issued photo ID (ex. Driver's license)
 EMT course completion certificate (minimum of 160 hours)
 Current and valid National Registry card
□ CPR card
 Must be at the BLS Provider/Healthcare Provider/Professional
Rescuer level
Complete the application and submit the certification fee
