- A. CurricUNET Test Site SLO Example: The committee reviewed the SLO example and recommend the following:
 - a) Student Learning Outcome
 - b) Method(s) of Assessment
 - c) Use of Assessment results in Academic Program Review
 - a. Action: Need to decide if Addendum to COR or how?

- B. Web team update: We are waiting to hear back from Linda Gilstrap who is the contact for the Web team. Last email from her was Nov. 7.

- C. Opening Day/Pre-opening day: Recommend Pre-opening day Staff Development option for programs to meet and write SLOs. Also Opening Day recommend ½ hour for Accreditation and then breakouts by schools for SLO development. Background materials can be shared before the end of the semester.
 - a. Goal: Orient to College Mission
 - b. SLO definition: use Julie Slark handout from 9/30/04 presentation at SWC.
 - c. Breakout by schools at staff development
 - 1) timeline for completion during spring 2008 with implementation fall 2009
 - 2) then break into groups by discipline/programs to write draft SLOs by program, degree, certificate and course (Goal is to get started.)
