GENERAL EDUCATION SLOS

- Complete requisite general education courses with a major emphasis, and have sufficient communication, thinking, and reasoning, information competency, and global awareness to qualify for an Associate's Degree.

TRANSFER SLOS

Students transferring to a 4-year college/university need a particularly strong academic foundation with an emphasis in critical thinking, research, data analysis, reading, writing, communication, mathematics, science and technology in order to succeed as upper division college/university students.

Upon completing Southwestern College's Transfer Program, the student will:
