- III. Spring SLO report: Eva Hedger was present to get clarification of Program SLOs and how to post these on CurricUNET. There was confusion because some faculty were writing Program SLOs for discipline content, while our college chose to follow the broader program definition for General Education, Transfer, Career Technical and Life Long Learning. We will add definitions to clarify this.

We also discussed the need for detailed definitions for our SLO terms. We will post these on our website. We decided to hold an extra meeting on Sept. 28 to make a decision about our "Discipline SLO" concept for discipline based content SLOs for a program leading to a degree, transfer or certificate. We also need to decide if we will stay with Core Competencies terminology and not move to the "Institutional SLO" term that appears to be replacing these. We will start with this on our agenda on the 28<sup>th</sup>.
