The CC reviews and scrutinizes curriculum for academic rigor, transferability and/or occupational competencies, student benefit, and institutional fit, as stated in Title 5 and the State Chancellor's Curriculum Handbook. Once these and other considerations are met, the CSR is forwarded to the Superintendent/President and Governing Board for review and approval before being sent to the State Chancellor's Office. The Southwestern College CC reviewed and approved 4 new courses, thirty-three (33) course modifications, 8 course inactivations, 2 new programs, 7 program modifications, and 1 program inactivation.
