ADMISSIONS AND CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT

References: Education Code Sections 76000, 76001, and 76002; Labor Code Section 3077

The District shall admit students in the following categories:

- Any person who possesses a high school diploma or its equivalent, or is enrolled in a qualifying apprenticeship program; and
- Other persons who are at least 18 years old and has the ability to benefit from the instruction offered.

Admission of Concurrently Enrolled Students (Grades 109-12)

• Any student who is enrolled in grades 10-12 is eligible to attend as a special part-time student for advanced scholastic or career and technical education courses.

The Superintendent/President, with the approval of the Academic Senate, shall establish procedures regarding ability to benefit from admission and admission of high school and younger students identified as highly gifted.

Claims for state apportionment submitted by the District based on enrollment of high school pupils shall satisfy the criteria established by statute and any applicable regulations of the Board of Governors.

The Superintendent/President shall establish procedures regarding compliance with statutory and regulatory criteria for concurrent enrollment.
