STUDENT AUDITING

The Governing Board of the Southwestern Community College District, under the provisions of Chapter 5, Section 76370.3 of the Education Code, hereby authorizes individuals to audit regularly scheduled credit courses, subject to the following conditions and stipulations:

- 1. A person must meet college eligibility requirements for admission to audit courses.
- A fee of fifteen dollars (\$15) per unit per semester shall be charged for each class audited. Students enrolled in classes to receive credit for ten (10) or more credit units shall not be charged a fee to audit three (3) or fewer semester units per semester. Additionally, the mandatory health fee must be paid.
- 3. No student auditing a course shall be permitted to change his or her enrollment in that course to receive credit for the course.
- 4. Priority in class enrollment shall be given to students desiring to take the course for credit.
- 5. Audit registration will be limited to the last day of the scheduled add/drop period and will require permission of the instructor of record, including his or her signature authorizing audit registration in the class.
- 6. A maximum of six (6) semester units may be audited in any regular instruction term (Fall, Spring, Summer).
- 7. Classroom attendance of students auditing a course shall not be included in computing the apportionment due the District.
