

INDEPENDENT STUDY

Independent Study courses are listed in the Course Description Section of the catalog with the designation number 299. A petition to take an Independent Study course must be approved by both the instructor and the Division Dean and filed in the Admissions Center during the first three weeks of the semester or the first week of summer session. To be eligible for Independent Study, a student must:

1. Be enrolled in one graded course;
2. Have completed at least one course in the subject or related areas or have demonstrated competence in the area in which he/she wishes to study;
3. Be in good academic standing (minimum of 2.0 G.P.A.) and maintaining a non-probationary status.

The maximum number of units a student can take in Independent Study courses is nine, with a maximum of six in any one department. All students taking an Independent Study course must turn in to the instructor of the course, at the end of the semester, an abstract of their Independent Study project or the project itself. Petition forms may be obtained in the Admissions Center. Enrollment fees and non-resident fees must be paid at the time of acceptance of petition.
