CONTINUOUS ENROLLMENT

Continuous enrollment is defined as completion of a course at least one semester in a calendar year excluding Summer Session. Completing a course is defined as receiving a grade of A, B, C, D, F, I, Credit or No/Credit. Receiving a grade of "W" will not satisfy the requirement for completing a course. An interruption of only one semester during a calendar year, excluding Summer Session, will not be considered as breaking the period of continuous enrollment insofar as student options are concerned in satisfying catalog requirements of Southwestern College.
