OVERVIEW

The Governing Board, at its meeting held December 11, 2013, approved the Community Benefits Agreement (CBA). Contained in the CBA is a requirement for the District to designate a "Project Labor Coordinator", to act on behalf of the District, to monitor and enforce compliance with the CBA.

In consideration of requirements listed above, the District Staff placed an advertisement, issued a Request for Proposal (RFP) 1314-1007R, and interviewed candidates for selection of the Project Labor Coordinator. The RFP and process was further vetted by attorney Thomas Kovacich, a partner at Atkinson, Andelson, Loya, Rudd & Romo, involved in the negotiations of the CBA.

Process:

The selection committee for this RFP process consisted of Angelica Suarez, Vice President for Student Affairs, Wayne Yanda, Director of Finance, Rachel Fischer, Deputy Director for San Diego Contracting Opportunities Center, Mark Claussen, Proposition R Program Manager (non-voting Observer of Process), Joe Stengel, Proposition R Senior Project Manager, Deborah Allen, Substitute Director for Procurement, Central Services & Risk Management (non-voting Observer of Process) and Linda Hernandez, District Planning & Facilities Coordinator (non-voting Observer of Process), who were responsible for reviewing the responses to the RFP, participating in interviews, and selecting the firm for contract award recommendation.

The District placed advertisements in three local publications. The RFP document was also made available on the District's Website as well as the ProGroup Technology Design Partner website and the San Diego Contracting Opportunities Center.
