Mental Health Issues in the Acute Care Setting: Recognition and Assessment DVD.N.03

Addresses the impact of mental health disorders on the delivery of healthcare in acute care environments. Illustrates safety issues, techniques for working effectively with these patients, the role of the nurse in coordinating care, and effective family interaction.

### **Pediatric Tips and Tricks**

Demonstrates how to prepare patients in five age groups (infants, toddlers, pre-school aged, school-aged, and adolescents) and their families for insertion on an IV catheter.
