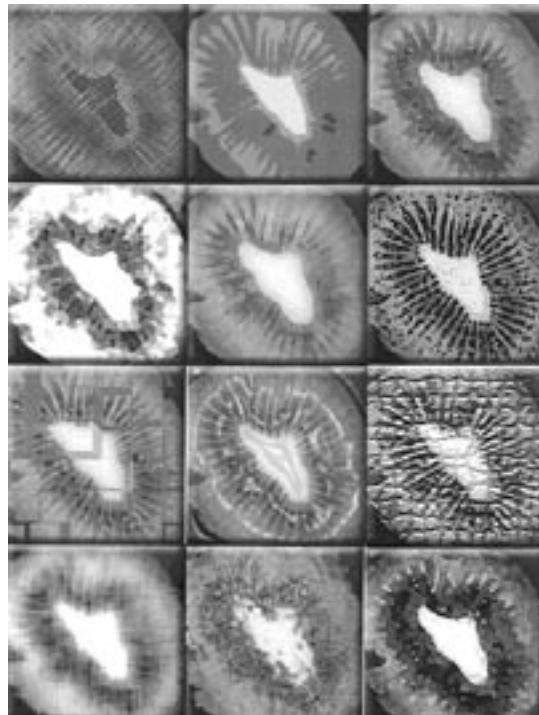


Gestalt

Grid, Structure, Contrast, and Repetition

Using the design principles of grid structure, contrast, and repetition, transform your found images into a finished modular design. Select interesting modules. Be sure that the image is clear showing detail and good contrast. Using Photoshop, make your selections and create four different documents.



In translating the photo collages into the final form use square selection modules. Each module will be a section of a photo you choose. It will also as part of a continuing image, one square relating to another. When combined, the effect will be of a composite of close-ups and general views of photos combined into a montage of imagery. While the imagery will be broken down and enlarged in various modules, you should strive for an abstract continuity of shapes and scale.

Arrange the modules in a new Photoshop document measuring 3" wide by 4" tall with a resolution of 180dpi. Don't be afraid to try something new. Strive for IMAGINATION & EXPERIMENTATION!
