- MyScripps a secure, convenient way for patients to manage their health care online.


Affiliated Medical Groups

Scripps Express Care, Urgent Care and Emergency Room

Scripps offers several options for care when the doctor's office is closed or a medical situation is severe.

HealthExpress

Scripps *HealthExpress* clinics offer same-day, walk-in care for minor illnesses and injuries throughout San Diego County every day of the year. No appointment is necessary, and early morning, evening and weekend hours are available. Patients can walk in, call ahead to speak to a triage nurse at **858-554-7439** or go to **scrippshealthexpress.org** to reserve a place in line and see wait times.

Urgent Care

Scripps has many urgent care centers that treat both adults and children in San Diego County. Please consult with your primary care doctor about urgent care centers affiliated with your medical group. Urgent care is a good option when there is a medical problem that should be seen by a doctor within 24 hours, but is not life- or limb-threatening.

Hospitals

Scripps has four nationally recognized hospitals on five campuses in San Diego County that provide a wide range of medical, surgical and support services, including emergency services open 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Scripps Mercy Hospital, San Diego and Scripps Memorial Hospital La Jolla are trauma centers that take care of the most severe injuries, often from accidents.
