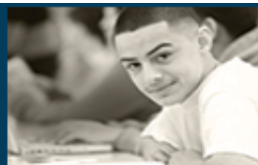

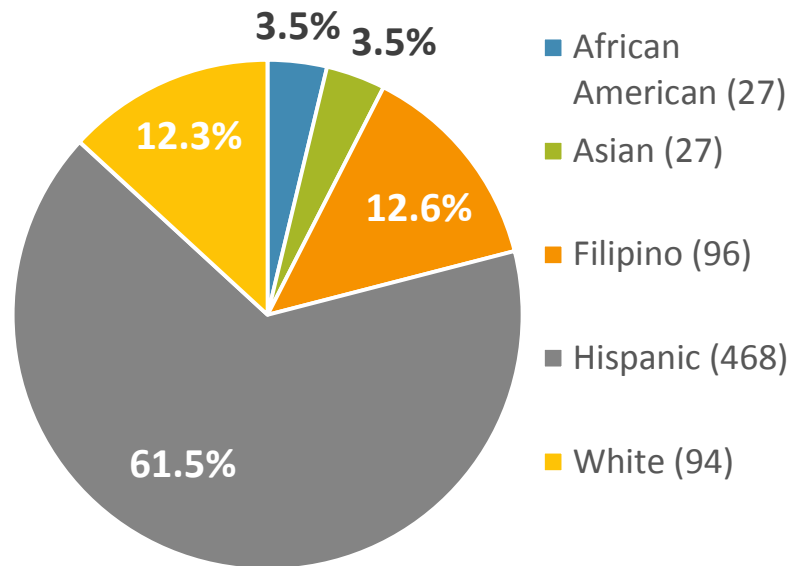

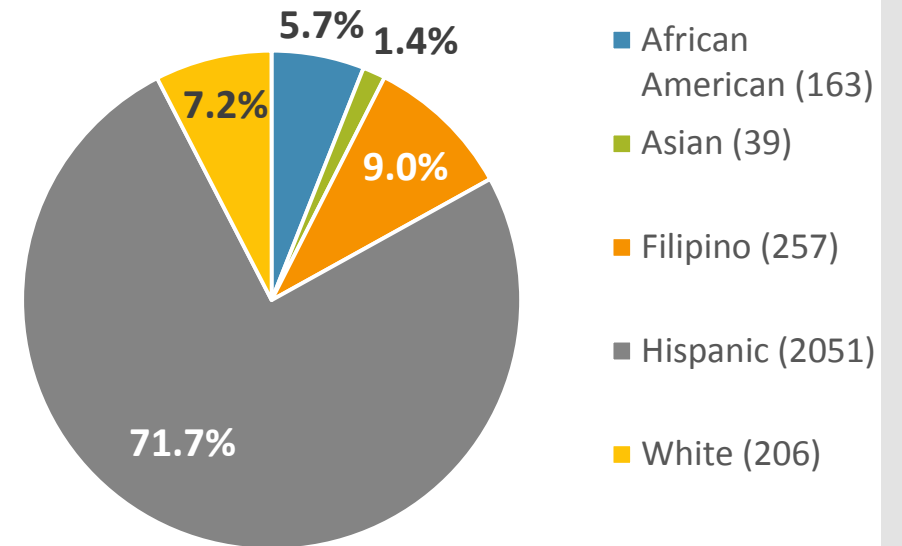
College-Prepared Students (n = 761)

Scorecard Completion Rates are **HIGHEST** among:

COLLEGE PREPARED:

- Females **62.4%**
- Under 20 years of age **60.2%**
- Asian and Filipino students **70.4%, 69.8%**

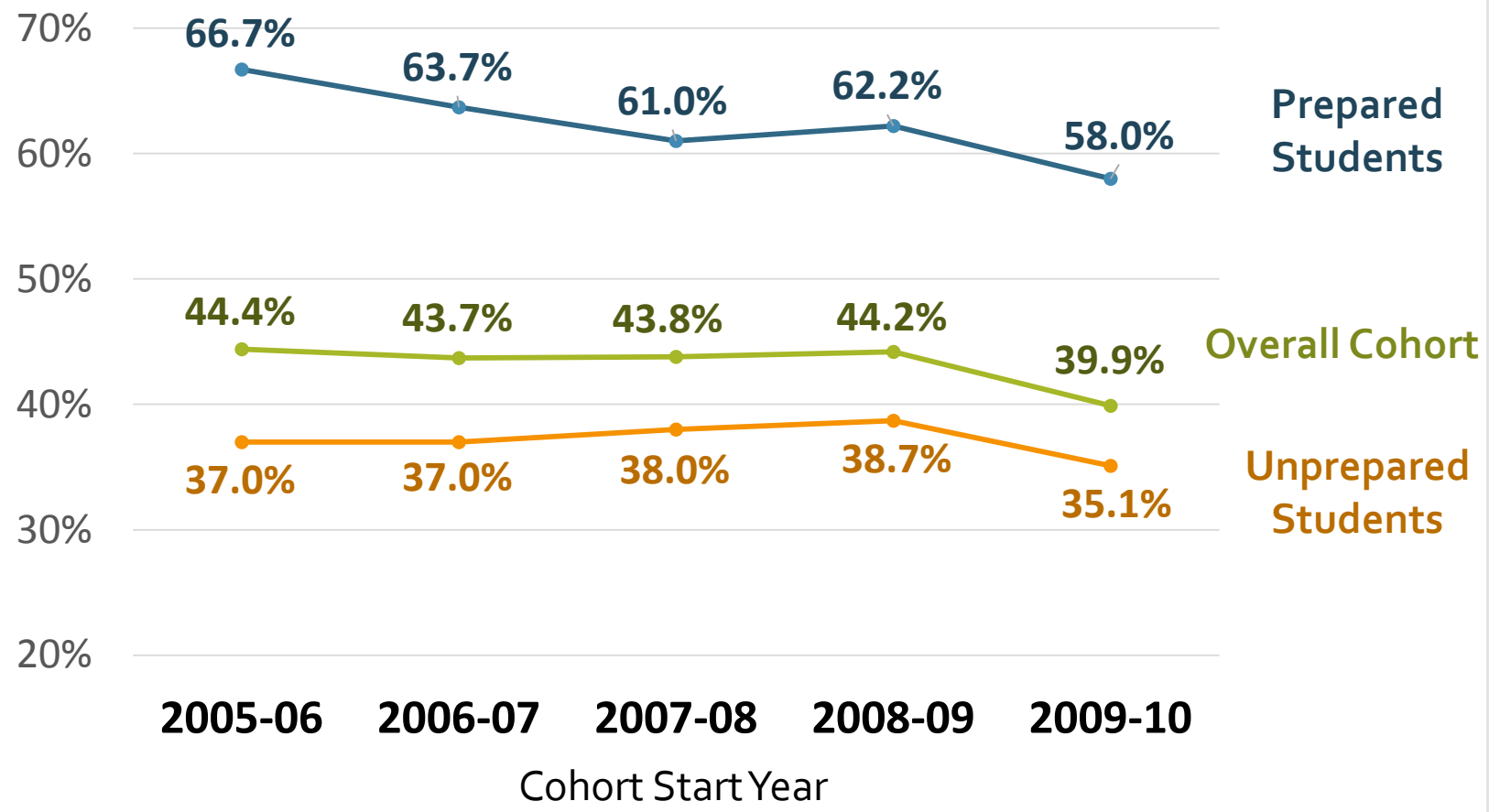
Scorecard Completion Rates are **LOWEST** among:

COLLEGE UNPREPARED:

- Males **31.4%**
- 20 to 24 year olds and 40+ **31.3%, 30.3%**
- Hispanic students **33.3%**

Southwestern College Scorecard Completion Rate, 5 Year Summary



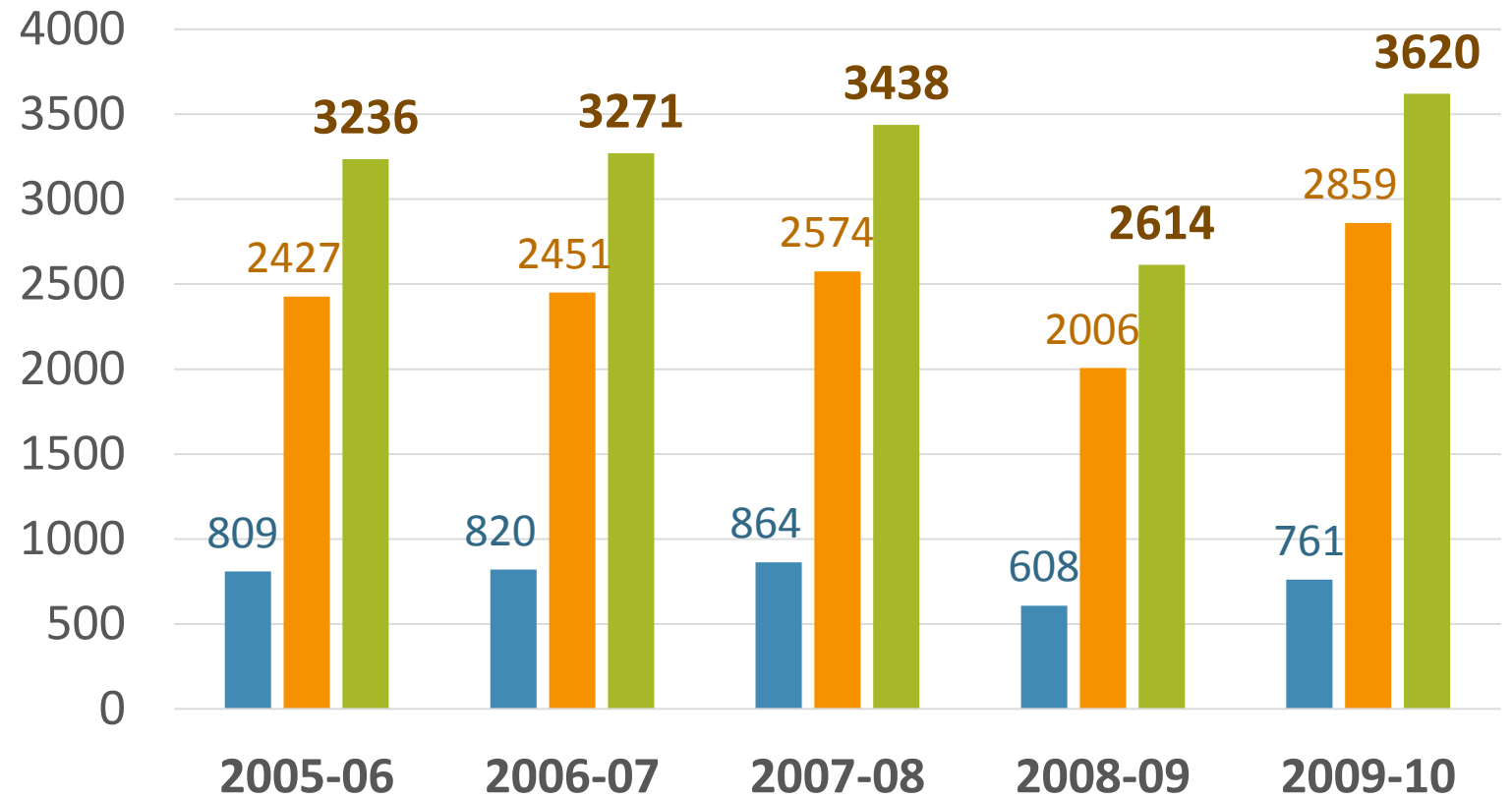

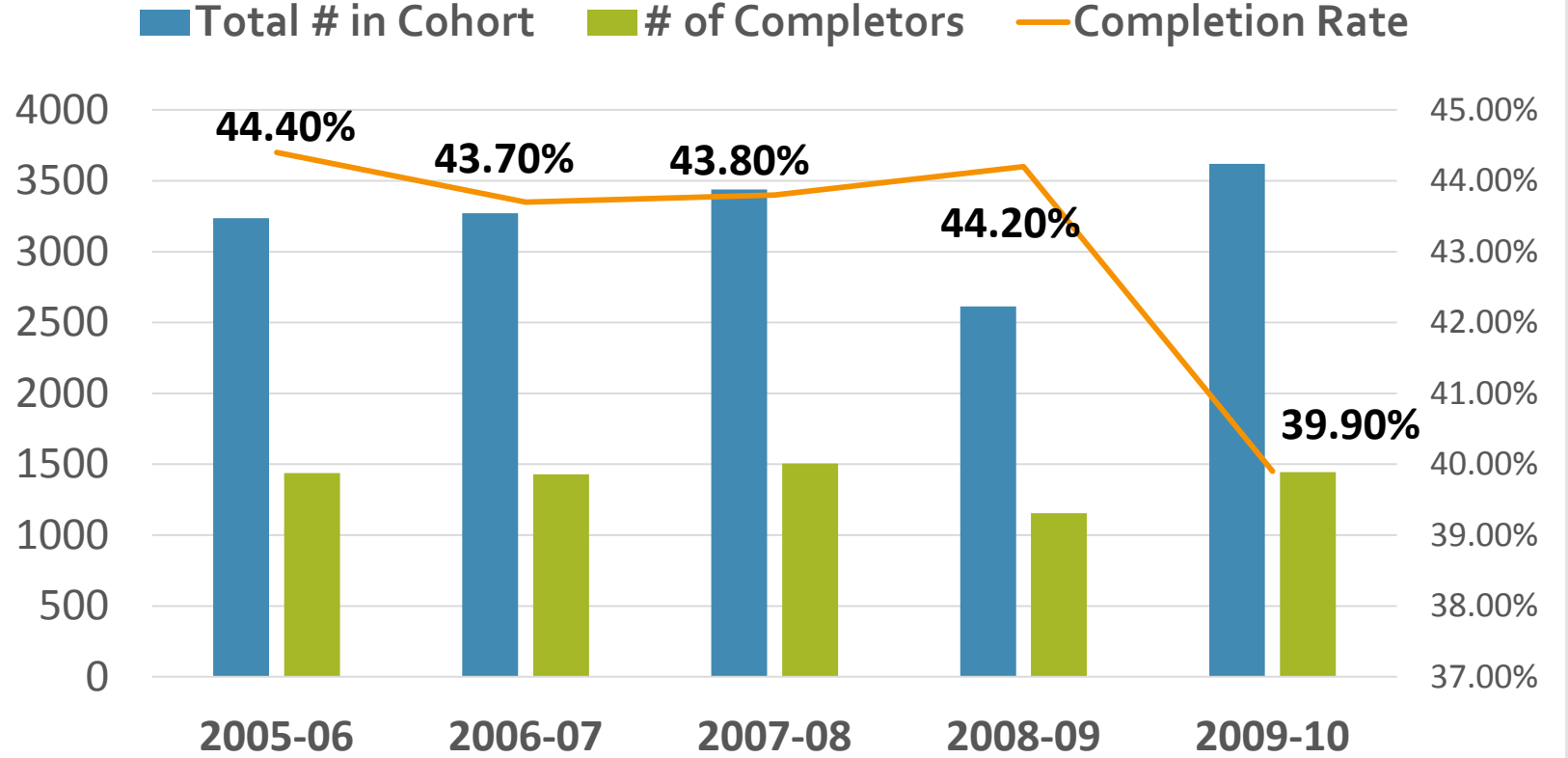

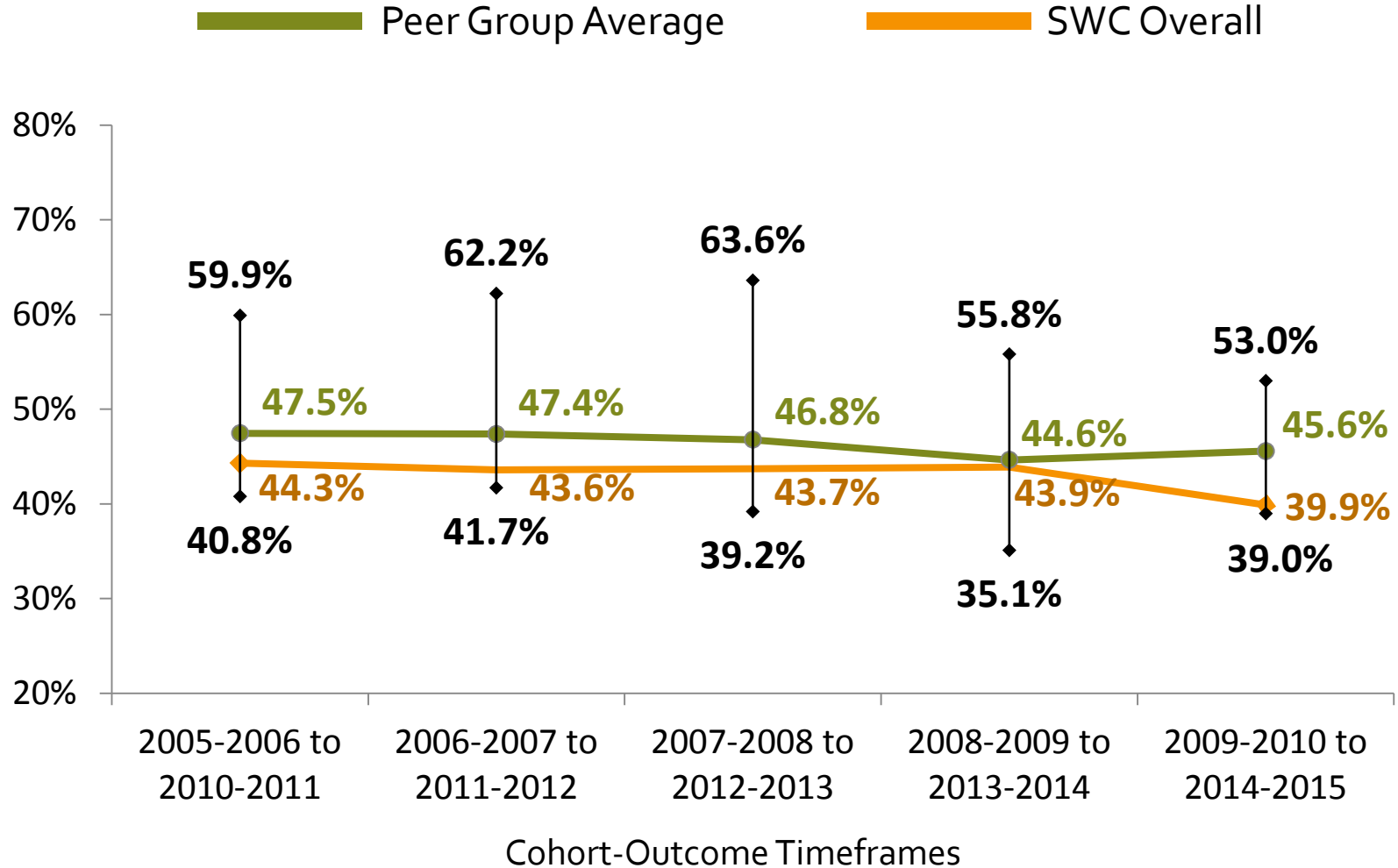

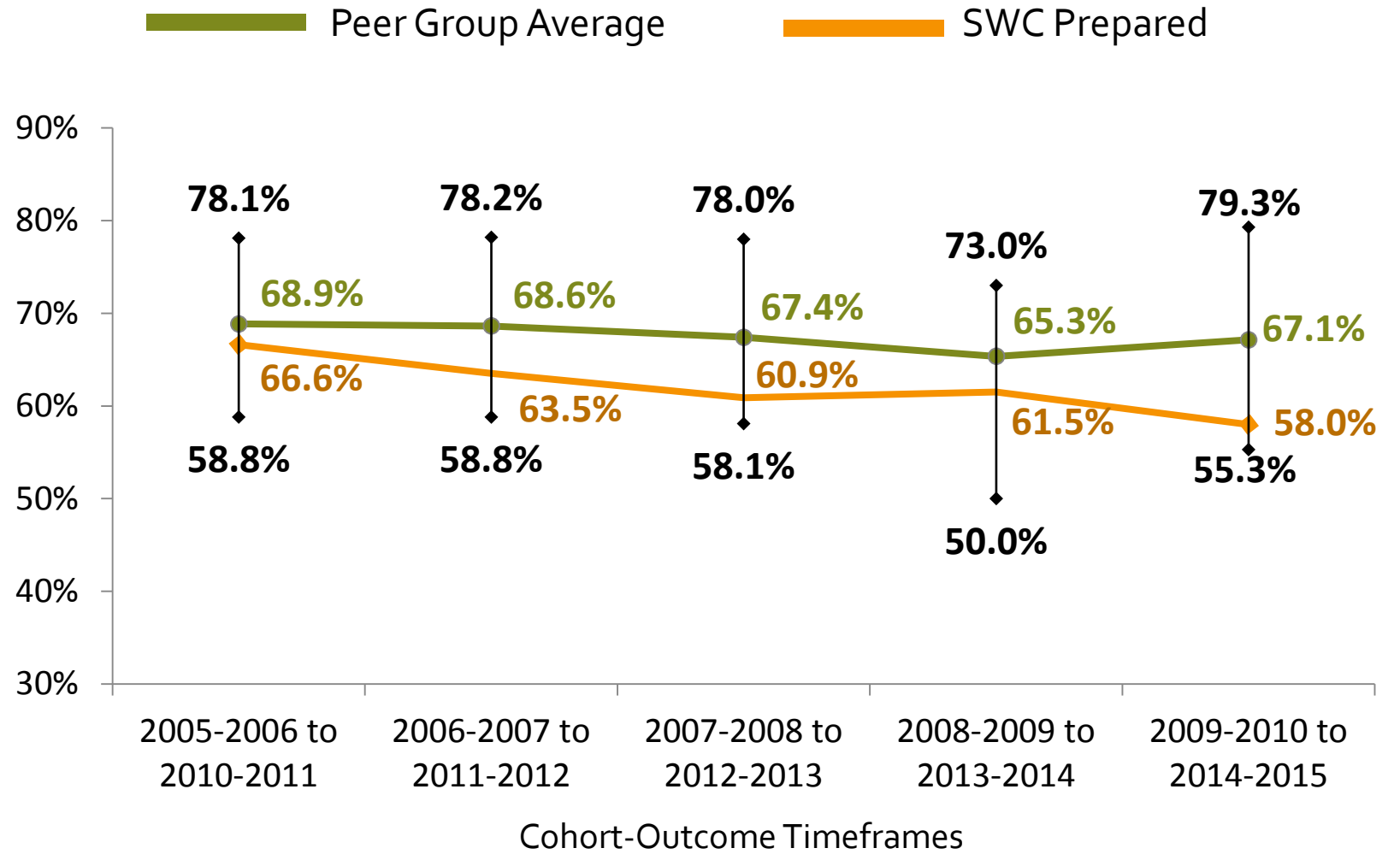

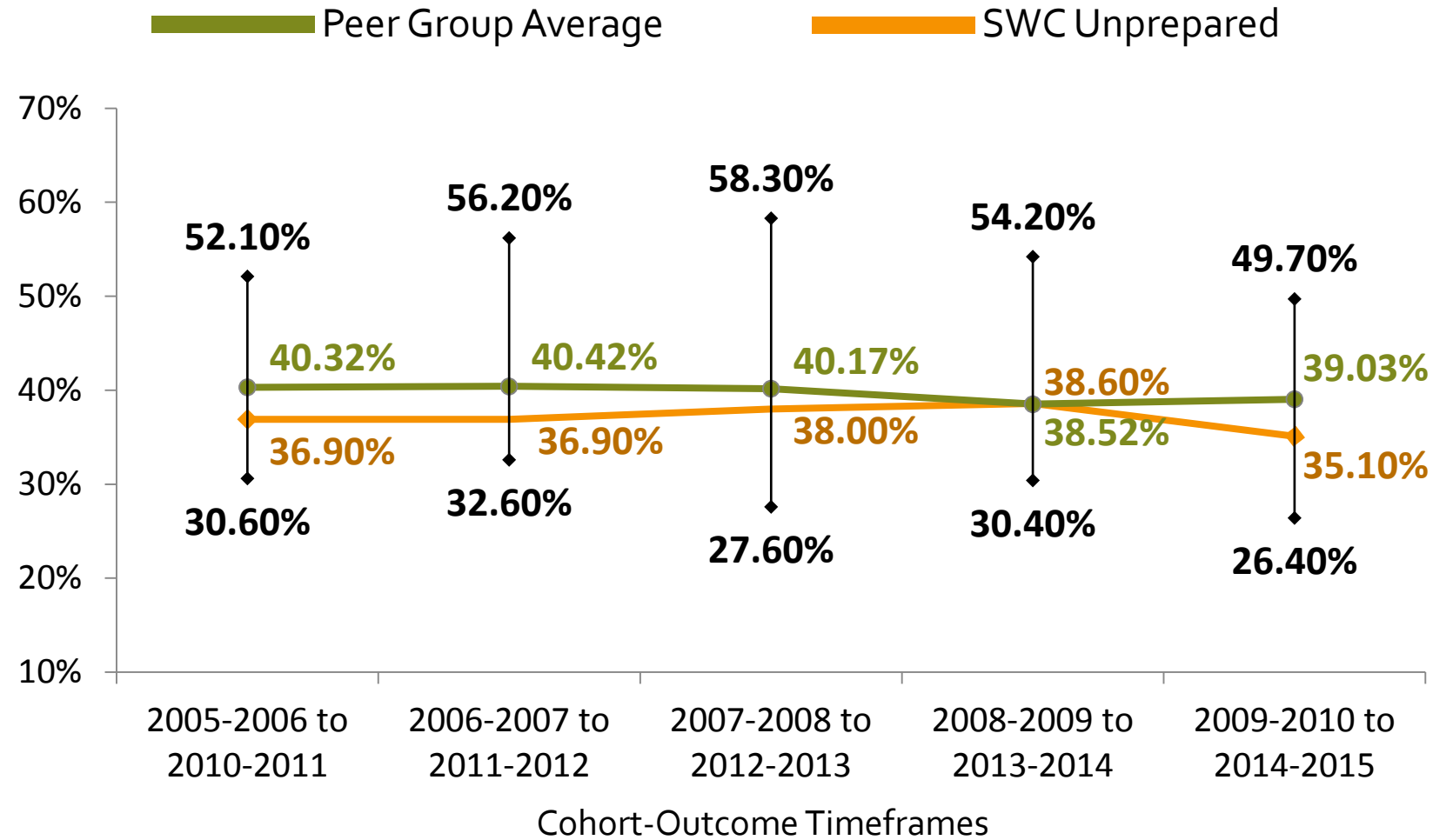

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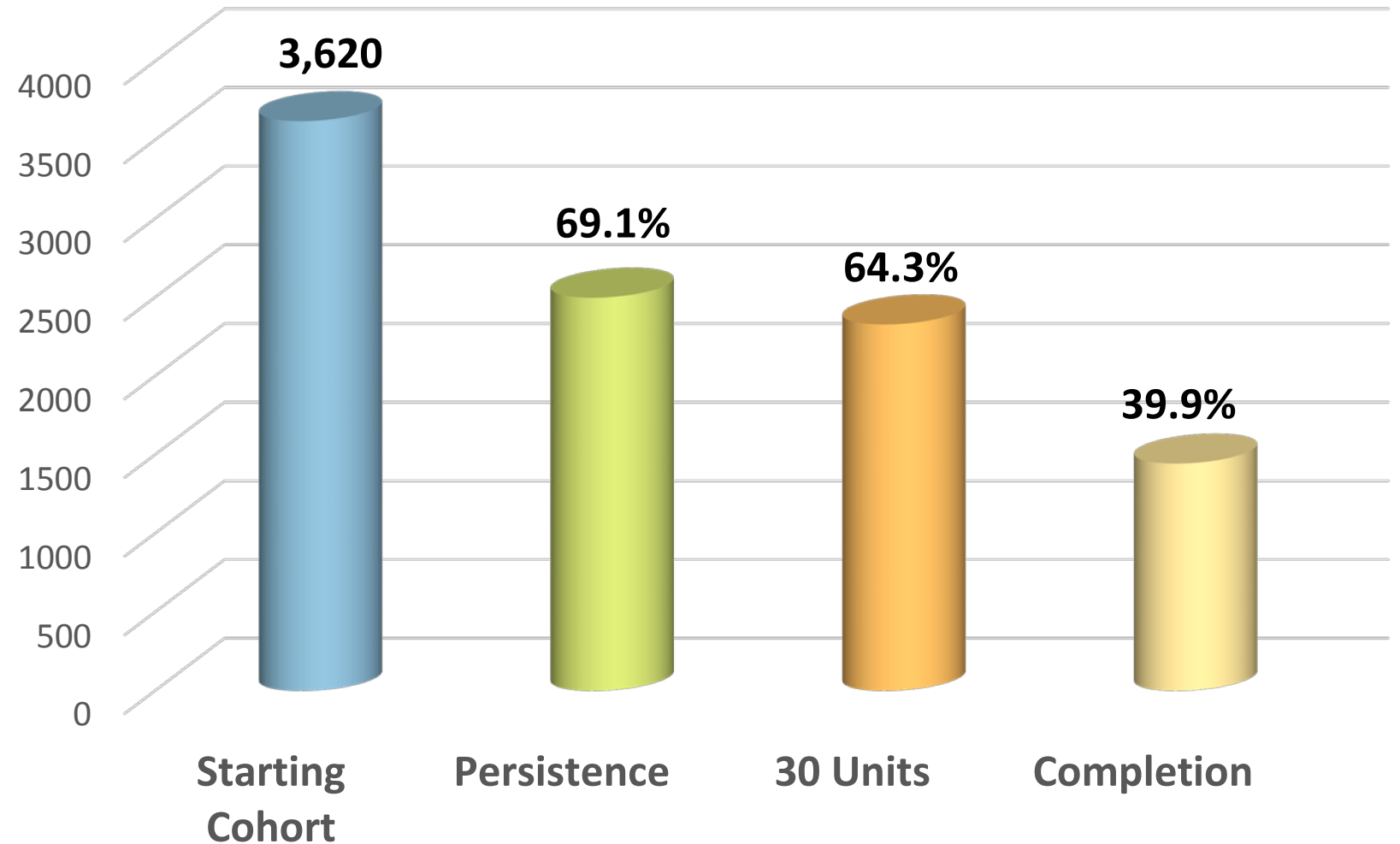

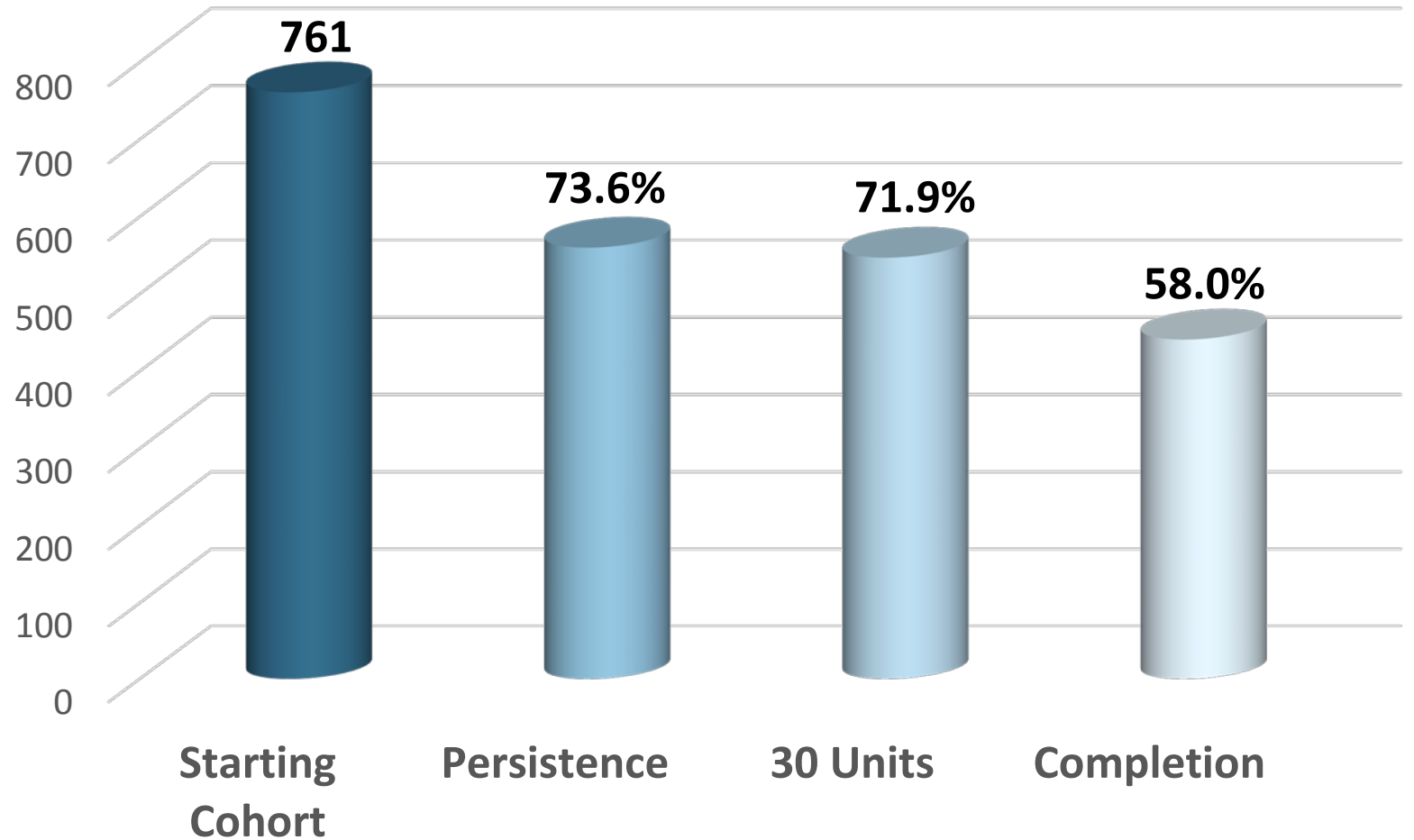

The Completion Pathway, Overall



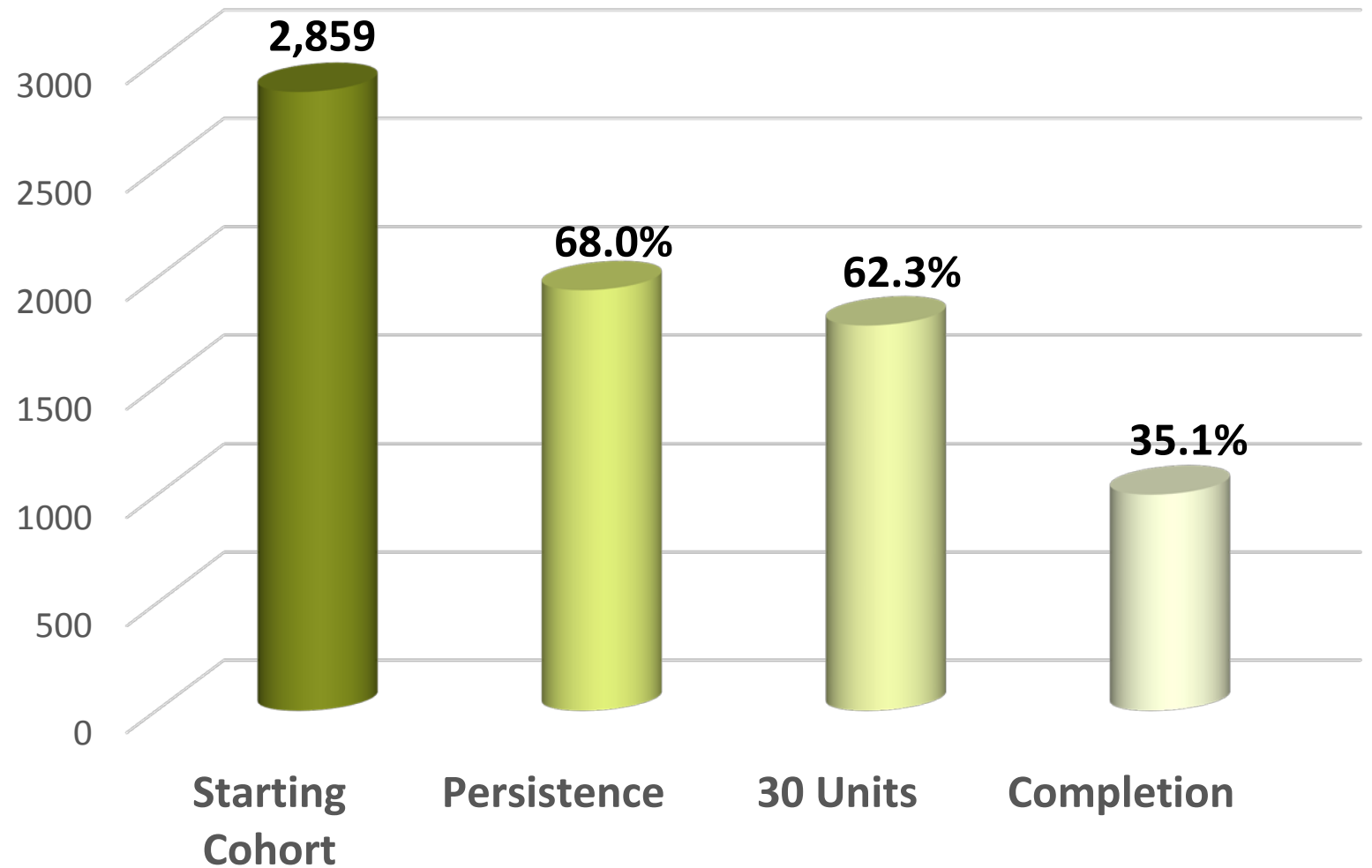
Overall Performance

Performance**

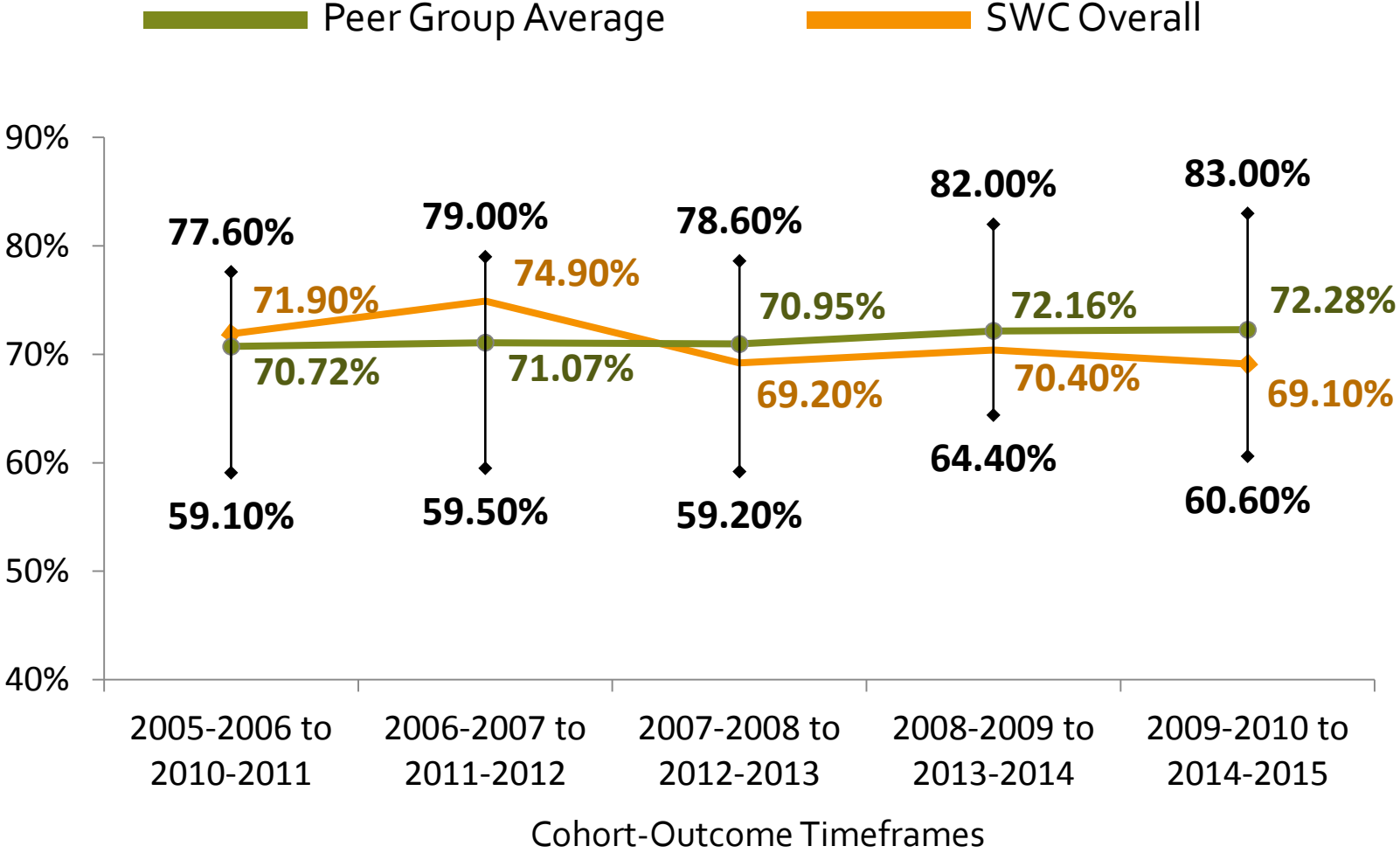

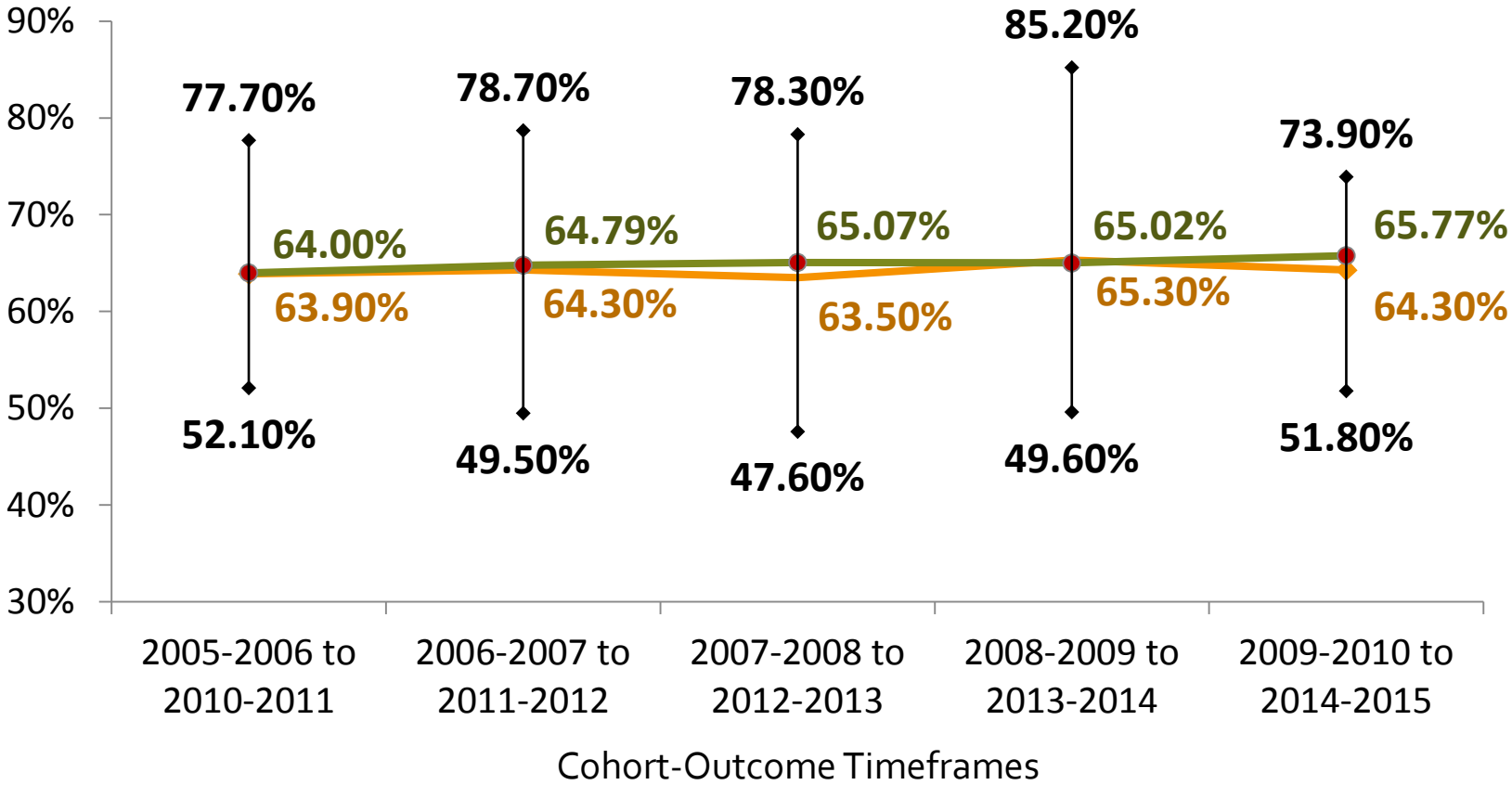

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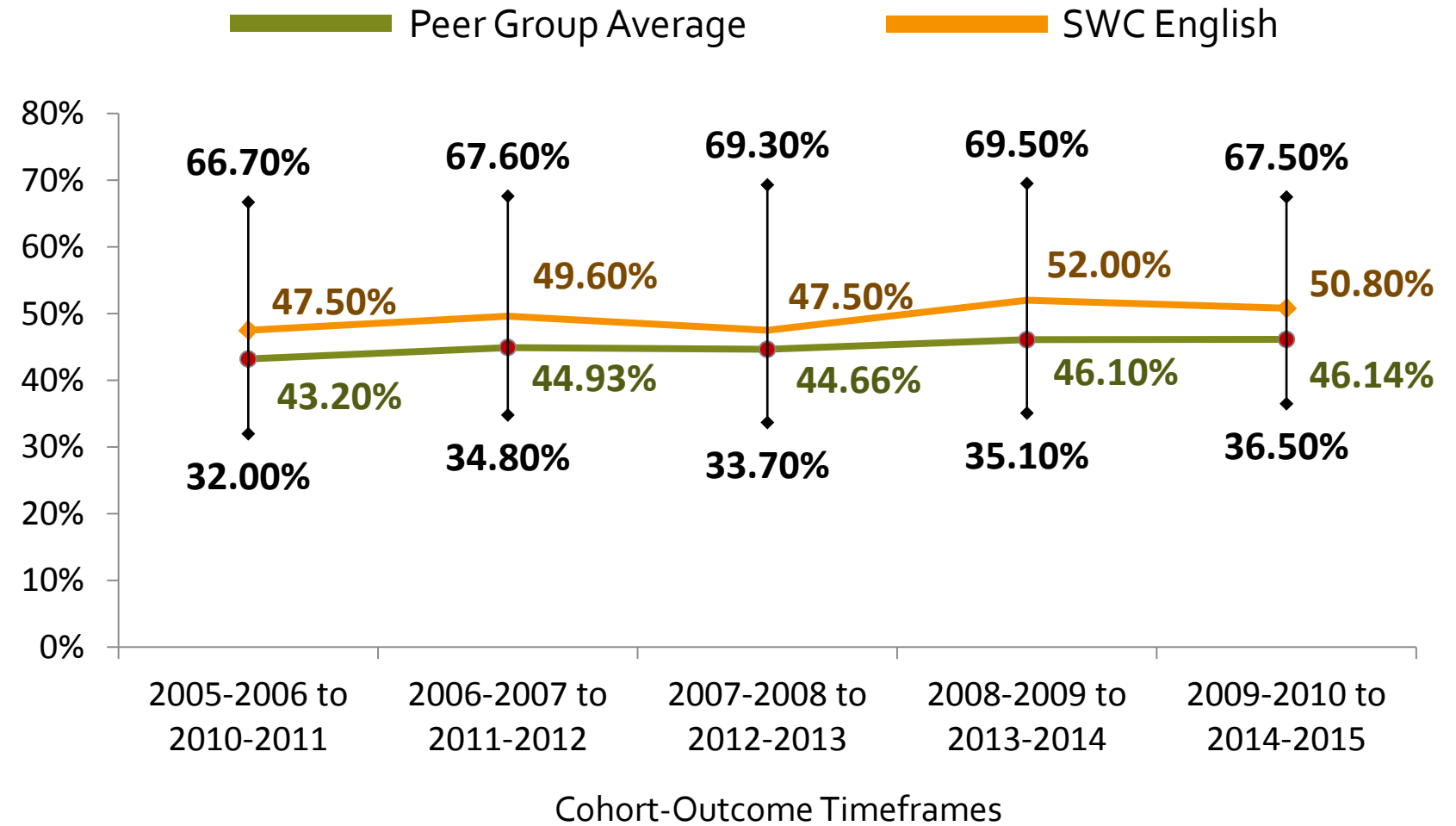
Peer Group Average (Green line) SWC Overall (Orange line)

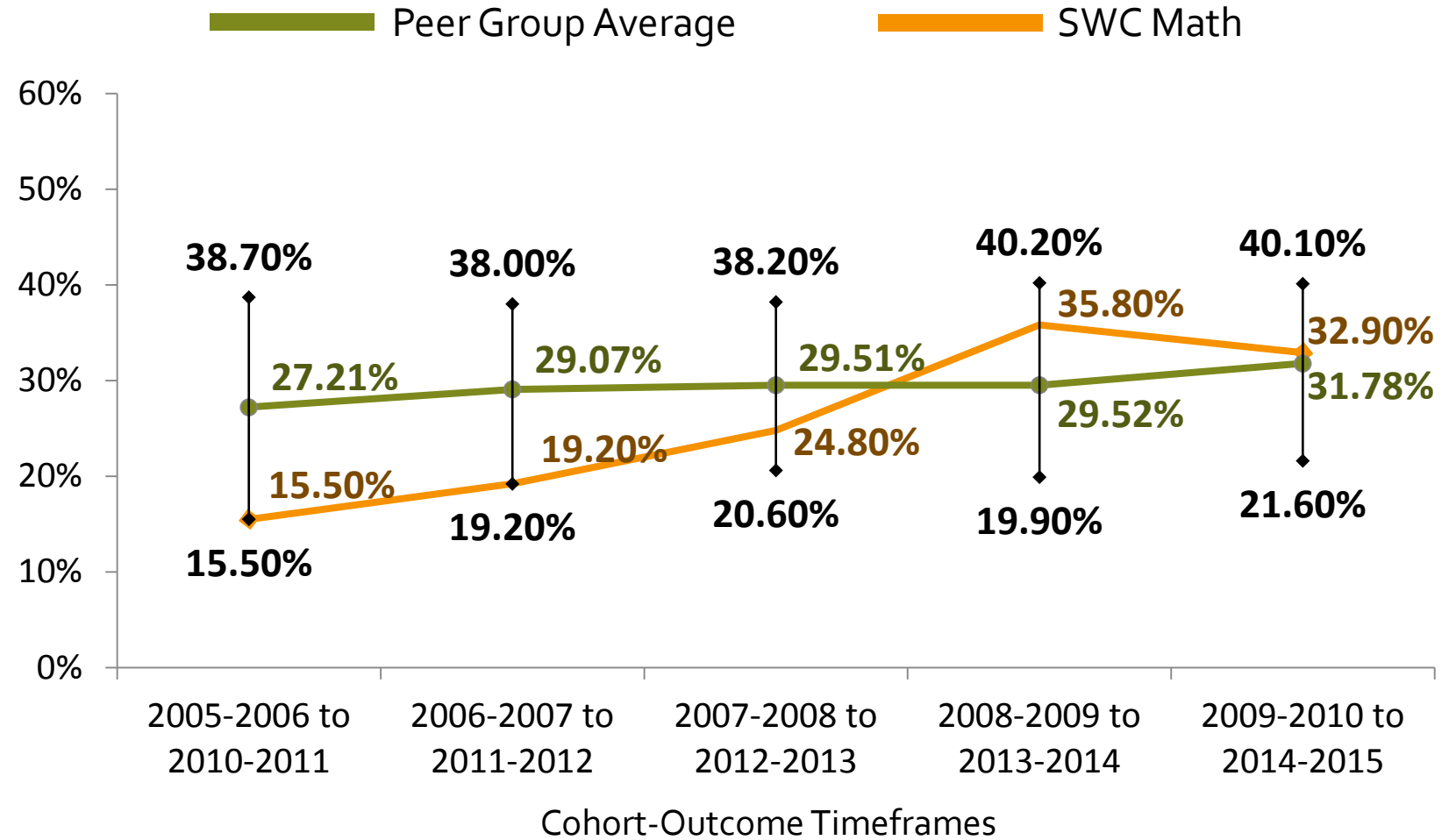

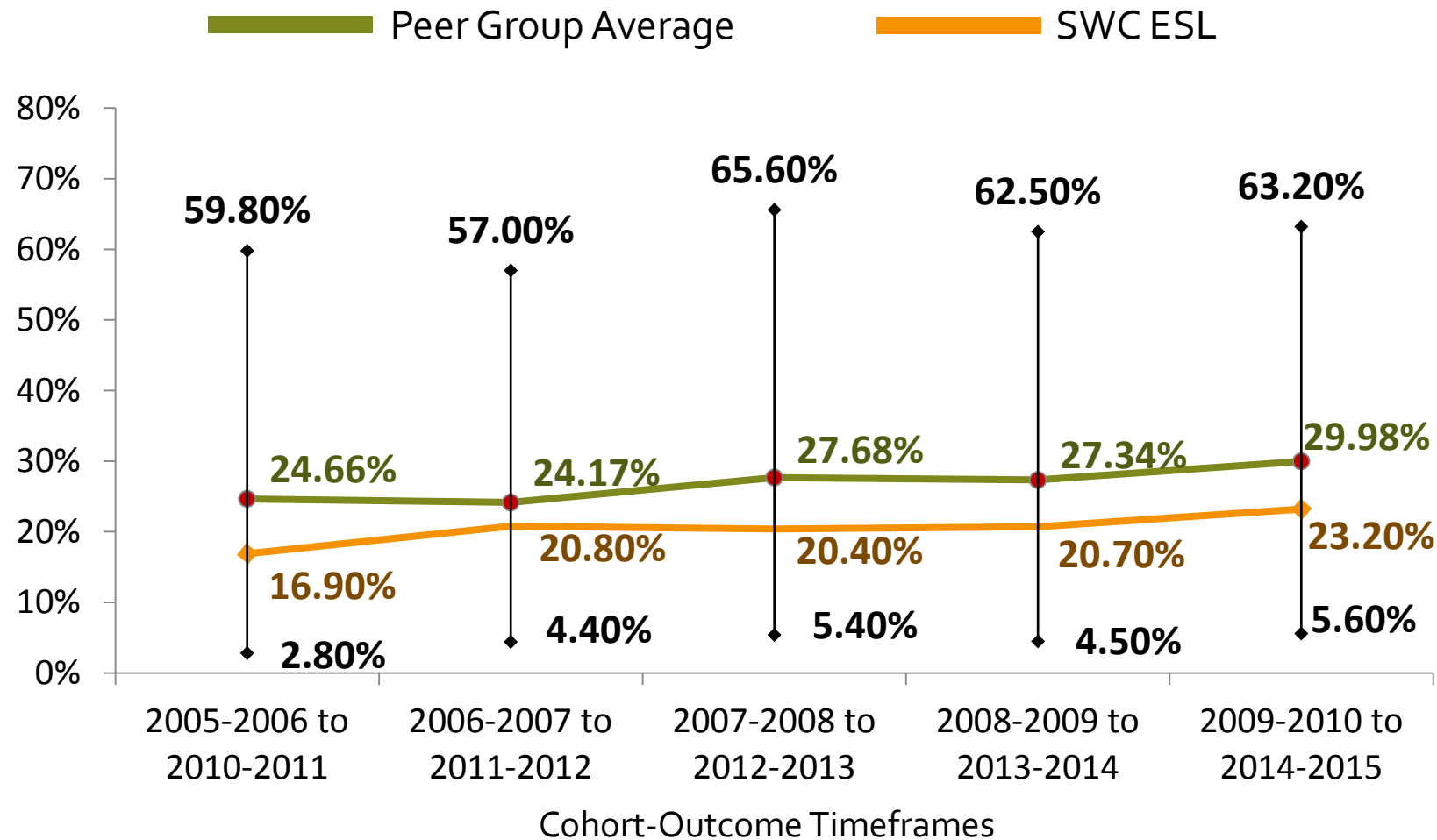

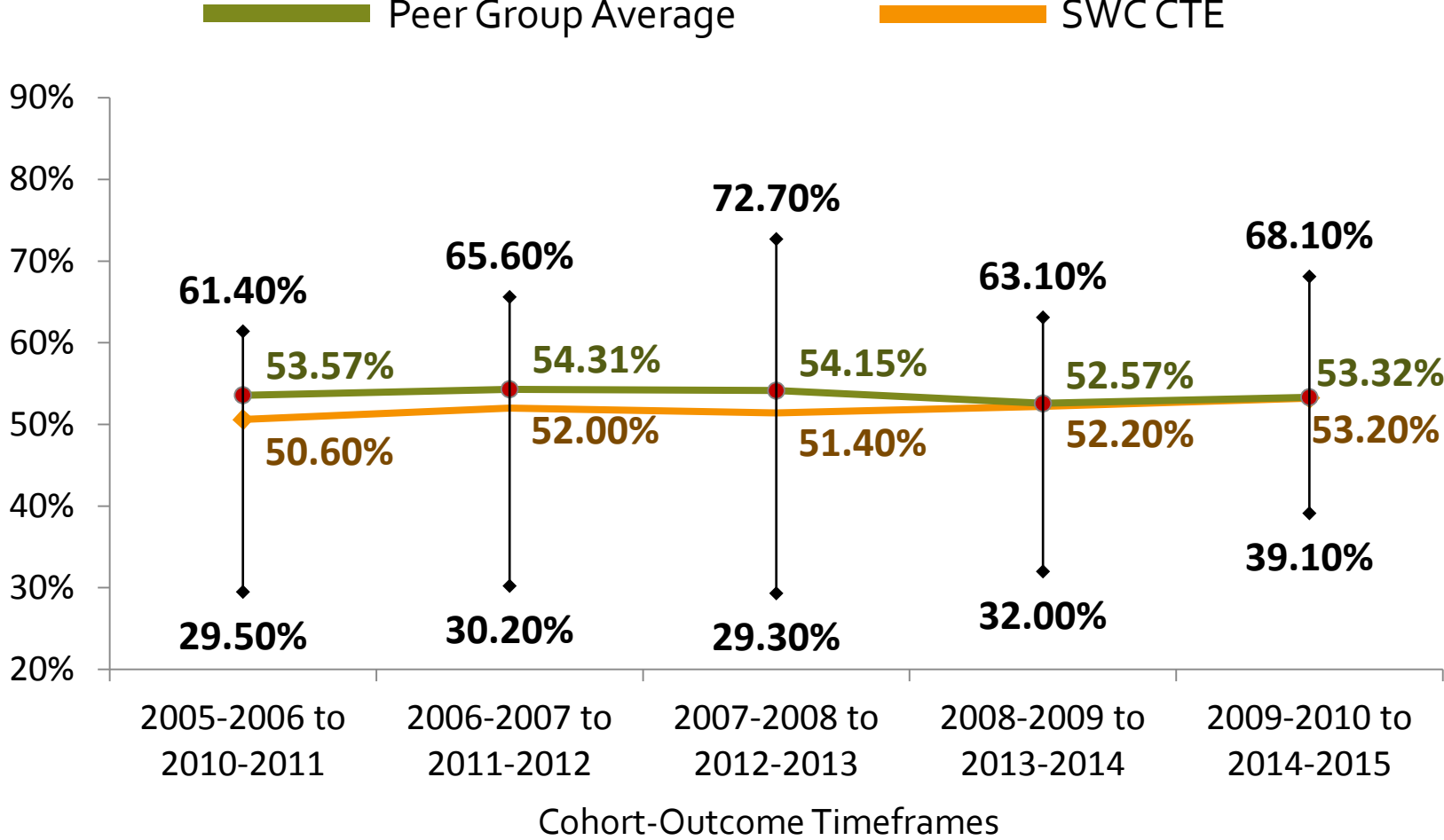

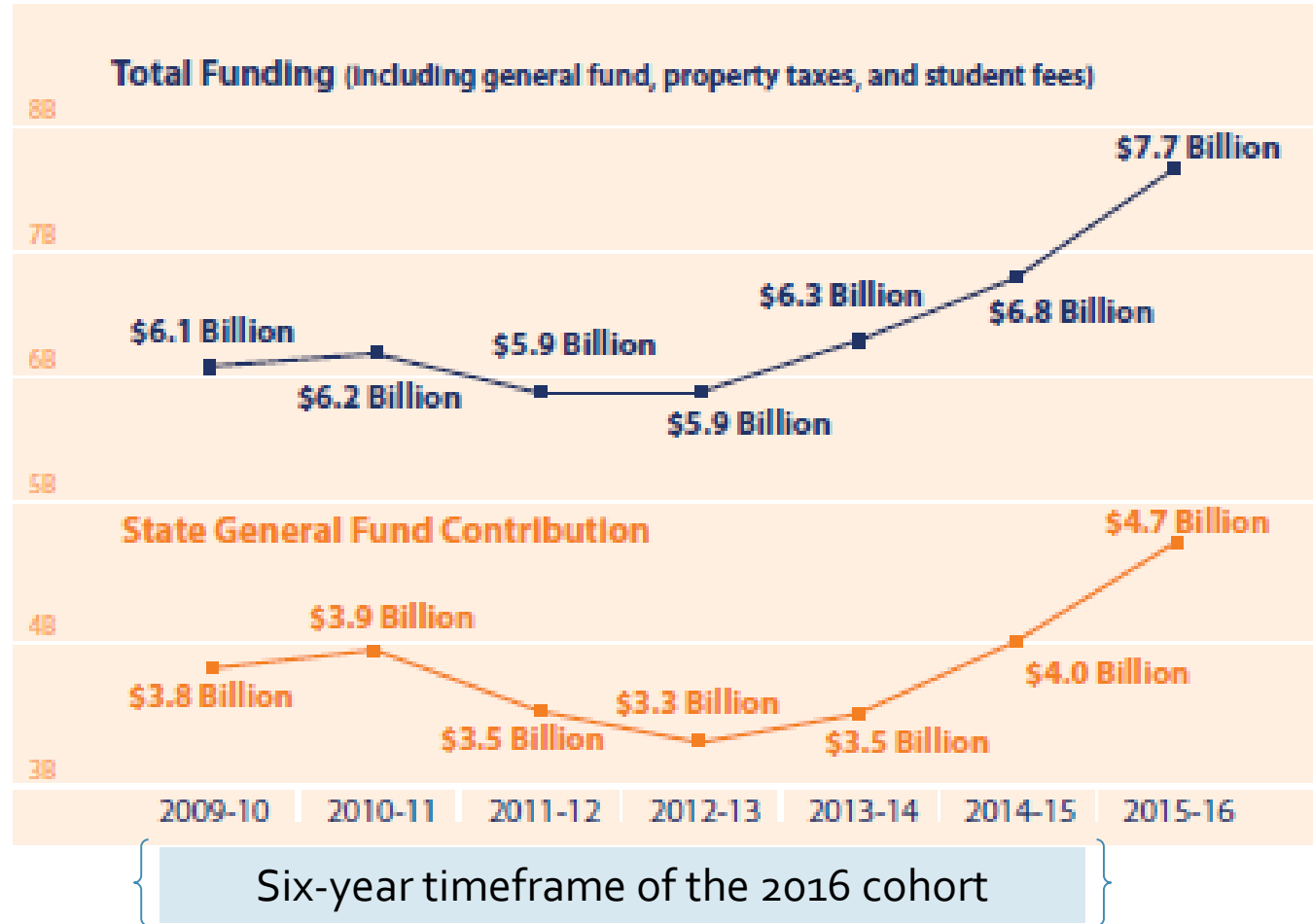

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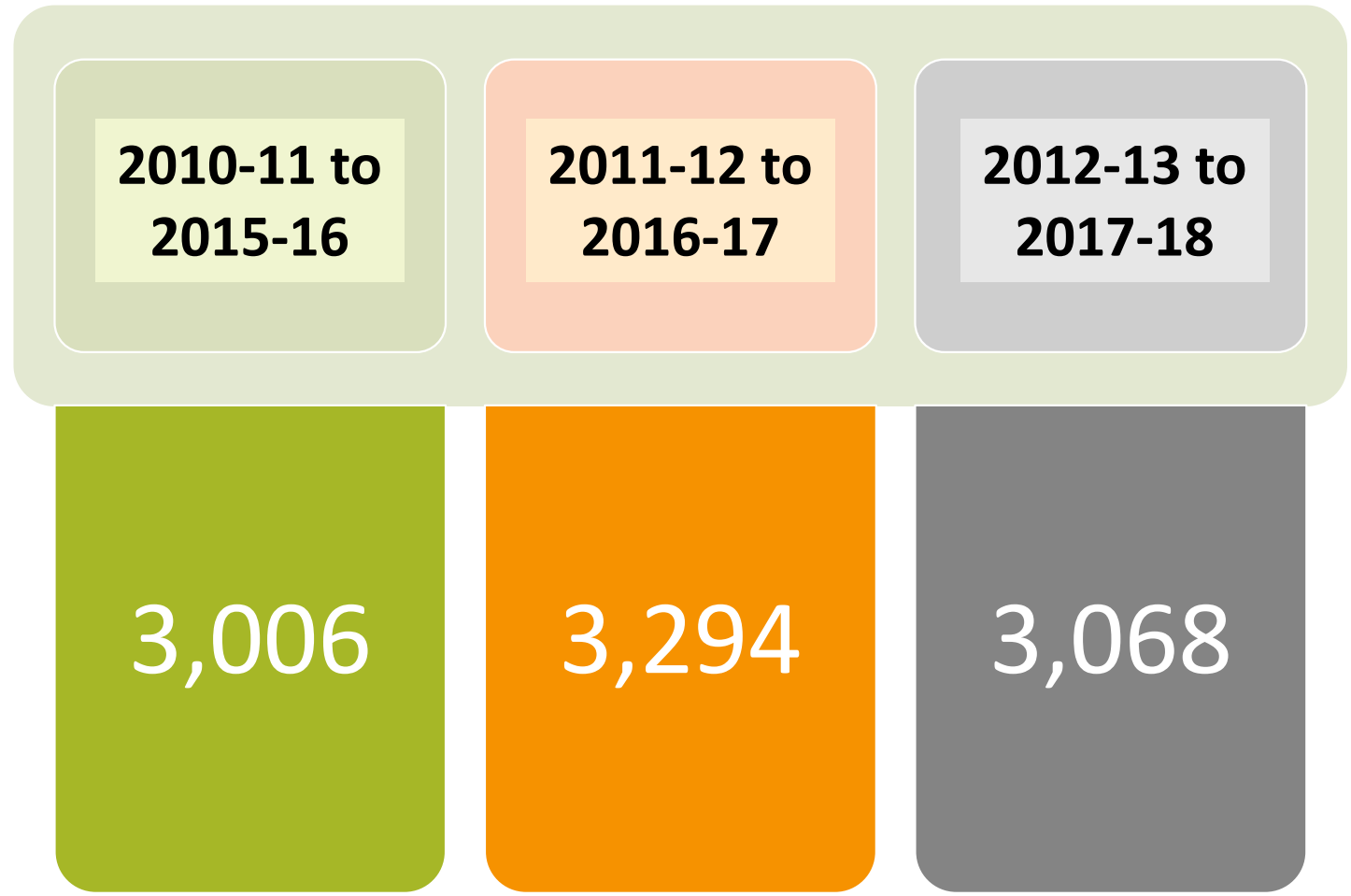
Changes Statewide: Funding
