DREAM ACT VERIFICATION WORKSHEET INDEPENDENT STUDENT INSTRUCTIONS

The DREAM ACT Verification Worksheet Independent Student requests 2023 income information about the student and spouse, if applicable. If you or your spouse filed a 2023 Federal Tax Return, you will need to request a 2023 Tax Return Transcript from the IRS and provide a copy to the Southwestern College Financial Aid Office.

Students and spouses who earned wages, but DID NOT file a 2023 Federal Tax Return, must provide copies of all W-2's. If wages were earned from the U.S. and not required to file a 2023 Federal Tax Return, you must also submit an IRS Verification of Non-filing Letter dated on or after 10/1/24, for you and your spouse.

Below you will find instructions on how to request an IRS Tax Return Transcript or Verification of Non-filing Letter. Submit your worksheet along with all requested documents to the SWC Financial Aid Office.

Tax Filers: How to request an IRS Tax Return Transcript

You are required to provide a copy of your and your spouse, if applicable, 2023 Tax Return Transcript and W-2's.

- 1. Contact the IRS at www.irs.gov/Individuals/Get-Transcript or call 1-800-908-9946.
- Be sure to request the "IRS Tax Return Transcript" and NOT the "IRS Tax Account Transcript."
- 3. You will need your Social Security Number, date of birth, and the address on file with the IRS. The address is the mailing address used when filing the 2023 IRS Federal Tax Return.
- 4. Alternatively, you can submit a completed paper 4506-T IRS Request for a Transcript of Tax Return that can be mailed or faxed to the IRS. You must check BOX 6a on the form to request a tax return transcript.

The transcript(s) requested, depending on the time of year, are generally received within 10 business days from the IRS's receipt of your request.

Non-tax Filers: How to request an IRS "Verification of Non-filing Letter"

Non-tax filers must submit a 2023 W-2 form for each source of employment income earned in the U.S. **AND** a "Verification of Non-filing Letter" from the IRS dated on or after October 1, 2024 attesting that you and your spouse, if applicable, did not file a 2023 IRS Federal Tax Return.

- 1. Contact the IRS at www.irs.gov/Individuals/Get-Transcript or call 1-800-908-9946.
- 2. Request the "Verification of Non-filing Letter."
- 3. You can also submit a completed paper IRS Form 4506-T IRS Request for Transcript of Tax Return that can be mailed or faxed to the IRS. You must check BOX 7 on the form to request the "Verification of Non-filing Letter."
