All periods of enrollment at Southwestern College and transferable units from other colleges (determined from official transcripts on file at SWC) will be included as part of the SAP review.			
The maximum time frame allowed for a student to maintain satisfactory academic progress is 150% of the minimum required units to complete an academic program. For example, 60 units is the standard length of completion for an Associate's Degree at SWC. Therefore, 60 units \times 150% = 90 units, which is the maximum units that a student is allowed to attempt and still be eligible for financial aid.
