<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>US Citizen or National.</b> Submit a <b>PHOTOCOPY</b> of your (1) US Birth Certificate, (2) US Passport/Passport Card (current or expired), (3) Certificate of Naturalization (form N-550 or N-570), (4) Certificate of Citizenship (form N-560 or N-561) <b>OR</b> (5) Documentation of Citizen Abroad (form FS-240, FS-545 or DS-1350).
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>US Permanent Resident.</b> Submit a <b>PHOTOCOPY</b> of your (1) Permanent Resident Card (form I-551 since 1997), (2) Resident Alien Card (form I-551 before 1997), (3) Departure Record (form I-94A) or Arrival/Departure Record (form I-94) with the endorsement "Processed for I-551. Temporary Evidence of Lawful Admission for Permanent Residence," (4) Visa in an unexpired foreign passport with a US Customs and Border Protection inspector admission stamp and the statement "Upon Endorsement Serves as temporary I-551 Evidencing Permanent Resident for 1 year" <b>OR</b> (5) US Travel Document (form I-327 with stamp "Permit to Re-enter").
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Refugee.</b> Submit a <b>PHOTOCOPY</b> of your (1) Departure Record (form I-94A) or Arrival/Departure Record (form I-94) with stamp showing admission as refugee under Section 207 of the Immigration and Nationality Act <b>OR</b> (2) US Travel Document annotated with "Refugee Travel Document Form I-571."
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Asylee.</b> Submit a <b>PHOTOCOPY</b> of your Departure Record (form I-94A) or Arrival/Departure Record (form I-94) with stamp showing admission under Section 208 of the Immigration and Nationality Act.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Parolee.</b> Submit a <b>PHOTOCOPY</b> of evidence, such as having filed a valid permanent resident application, from the Department of Homeland Security, that you are in the US for other than a temporary purpose and intend to become a citizen or permanent resident. Documentation <b>MUST</b> have stamp indicating you have been paroled into the US for at least one year, with a date that has not expired.
<input type="checkbox"/>	<b>Victim of Human Trafficking (or Spouse, Child or Parent of Victim).</b> Victim must submit certification letter from the Department of Health and Human Services. Spouse, child or parent of victim must submit a <b>PHOTOCOPY</b> of the victim's certification letter and of their T-Visa.

Ineligible Categories:

- Applicant for Permanent Resident Status and not in a category listed above
- A student with a non-immigration Visa
- A student with only an Employment Authorization
