ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR MEXICAN CITIZENS - F-1 BORDER COMMUTER/FRONTERIZO VISA



What is the F-1 Border Commuter/Fronterizo visa?

- This enrollment and visa status is designed for students who commute to SWC from Mexico on class days. Students must return to Mexico each day after classes, as this visa does not permit overnight stays or residency in the U.S. It is strictly for educational purposes, typically from Monday to Friday, and cannot be used for crossing the border at night or on weekends.

Academic Documents

- High school transcripts (showing the last 6 semesters)
- High school diploma.
- English Proficiency Exam (optional)
 - TOEFL (55), Duolingo (75), or IELTS (5.5).
 - If you do not have this exam, you can enroll in the academic English program at SWC.



Documents for the F-1 Fronterizo Visa

- Copy of valid Mexican passport.
- Proof of financial support for **\$2,000** USD. Bank statements under the student's name or sponsors who will provide the financial support.
- Proof of residency in the approved binational region.
