ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR MEXICAN CITIZENS - F-1 INTERNATIONAL STUDENT VISA



What is the F-1 International Student visa?

- This enrollment and visa is intended for students who will reside in the U.S. while attending SWC. Students must maintain a full-time course load throughout their enrollment.

- You will need to fill out the online form, including personal information and address.

Academic Documents

- High school transcripts (showing the last 6 semesters)
- High school diploma.
- English Proficiency Exam (optional)
 - TOEFL (55), Duolingo (75), or IELTS (5.5).
 - If you do not have this exam, you can enroll in the academic English program at SWC.



Documents for the F-1 International Student Visa

- Copy of valid Mexican passport.
- Proof of financial support for **\$20,500** USD. Bank statements under the student's name or sponsors who will provide the financial support.
- Proof of residency in the approved binational region.
