ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR U.S. CITIZENS



U.S. Citizens who reside in Baja California

- The AB 91 program is available for Mexican or U.S. citizens residing in the approved binational region, which includes Baja California cities located within 72 kilometers (45 miles) of the US-Mexico border, and who are 18 years or older. There is no maximum age restriction for participants.

Academic Documents

- High school transcripts (showing the last 6 semesters)
- High school diploma.
- English Proficiency Exam (optional)
 - TOEFL (55), Duolingo (75), or IELTS (5.5).
 - If you do not have this exam, you can enroll in the academic English program at SWC.



Proof of Residency

- Copy of U.S. identification document
- Copy of proof of residence in Tijuana
