SB 98 Immigration Enforcement
Quick Reference Sheet

IF YOU SEE IMMIGRATION ENFORCEMENT ON CAMPUS

1. Maintain a Calm Environment

Keep interactions professional. Do not interfere or engage with officers.

2. Call Campus Police

Immediately notify Campus Police: Extension 6691 or (619) 216-6691



3. Hold Info

No information, records, or documents may be shared.
Direct all inquiries to Campus Police.



4. No Access

Access to non-public areas requires a warrant and you are not authorized to engage with them. Refer them to College Police.



NOTIFICATION PROTOCOL

Once Campus Police confirms immigration enforcement is present:

- The District will immediately send out a notification through District emergency systems.
- Make note of all details for documentation.
- You may record incident on your phone so long as you are not physically intervening.

AFTER THE INCIDENT

Once Campus Police confirms immigration enforcement has ended:

- An 'All Clear' message will be sent when enforcement has left through District emergency system.
- Students and employees will be directed to support services such as counseling, immigration resources and legal assistance.
