 the tunnel you will see our building.

- Aquatic Camp is full day (9am-4pm) offering multiple aquatic activities such as kayaking, standup-paddle boarding, surfing, sailing, swimming as well as team building games and instruction all at Silver Stand State Beach.

- There will be four (4) 5-day sessions that run late-June through late-July.
