TEAS Testing

TEAS Version 6 was updated and released by ATI on August 31, 2016

Updates:

- TEAS test score must be within the last three years (*Effective 6/2021).
- TEAS Version 7 will be released by ATI in June of 2022.
- Test prep materials will be available on the ATI website (<u>www.atitesting.com</u>) starting February 2022.
- TEAS Version 7 will be required by SWC Nursing after June 2022.

TEAS study guide and online practice tests are <u>highly</u> recommended to prepare for TEAS exam

You may take a remote TEAS test. Create an ATI account using the ATI website and select a testing institution setup to do remote proctoring (testing).

SWC Nursing Requirements:

Passing composite TEAS score for:	
ADN/RN Program:	62% or higher
VN Program	58% or higher

If your score on the first TEAS test is 61% or less for ADN/RN Program or 57% or less for the VN Program, you MUST complete remediation as outlined in the "TEAS REMEDIATION PLAN."

TEAS REMEDIATION PLAN

(For applicants with an Adjusted TOTAL Score **less than 62%** for the ADN/RN Program or **less than 58%** for the VN Program)

REMEDIATION PROCESS

- You may use one of the following methods for remediation:
 - 1. Attend and complete a TEAS prep course. These are occasionally offered at various educational sites throughout the county

OR

2. Review a TEAS study manual and take two practice TEAS tests from ATI (www.atitesting.com)

The following remediation criteria must be met:

- Remediate within one year of 1st TEAS test date
- 2nd TEAS test must be taken within one year of 1st TEAS test
- Proof of remediation completion is <u>required</u> with your Nursing Program application (i.e. proof of completion of a TEAS course or a copy of your ATI TEAS unofficial transcript showing all tests and test prep taken).
