A Home Health Aide (HHA) provides essential in-home care to individuals who need assistance with daily living activities and basic medical support. They help clients maintain their independence and quality of life by assisting with tasks like bathing, dressing, grooming and mobility.

Program requirements, class schedule and related information are summarized below:

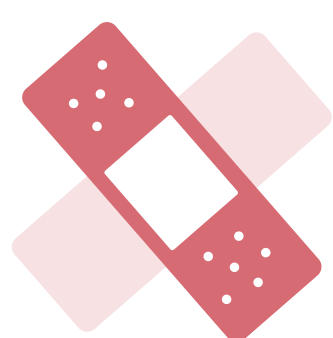
- CNA certification required
- Two-week course (40 hours total):
- Mon. (5 hrs.), Tue. (5 hrs.), & Wed. (10 hrs.)
- Class dates: August 10, 11, 17, 18
- Clinical dates: August 12, 19
- 15 students maximum
- Approved by CDPH for CNA Continuing Education Units (CEUs)
- Up to 26 CEUs granted for CNA renewal
- HHA is a “non-credit” class (no credits earned; no enrollment fees paid).
- NC-443-301 (students will be enrolled in this course)

The estimated total cost of the program is \$200 (subject to change). Costs include textbooks, uniforms, parking, Compio (background/drug screening) and malpractice insurance. Students are required to purchase malpractice insurance; the cost is currently \$13 (subject to change). The college has a blanket policy which covers the students for \$1,000,000/\$5,000,000 per year.

The program will accept up to 15 students. All the students are expected to meet on the first day of class. Accepted students who fail to attend the first class will be dropped and will have to re-apply for the next available course.

Complete applications will be the priority for program admission. All students are notified of their status via SWC e-mail. **For application, email nursing@swccd.edu**
