### STEPS TO APPLY

# **STEP 1** – REQUIREMENTS:

You must meet the following requirements before you can be eligible to apply to the Police Academy.

- 1. Minimum Age -21 years
- 2. High School Graduate or G.E.D. Equivalency completed in the United States
- 3. No Felony Conviction
- 4. Valid State of California Driver License
- 5. SWC Student ID# if you are currently not a student go to <a href="www.swccd.edu">www.swccd.edu</a>, click on *Apply and Register* on the main page.
- 6. Meet prerequisite course levels:
  - Eligibility for English 115 with support or higher
    - a. Reading 158 or proficiency is meet with eligibility into English 115
  - Eligibility for Math course equivalent to or higher than Pre-Algebra.

### You have four (4) options to meet the prerequisite course levels listed above:

a) If you completed the above courses under #6 above at Southwestern College, provide an unofficial copy of your transcripts upon applying to this program.

**Note:** Students who have taken courses or are enrolled at Southwestern College (current or past) are required to provide proof of 2.0 GPA or higher; if your GPA is under a 2.0 it is highly possible that you might be on Academic Probation and would be disqualified from applying to the Police Academy.

b) If the above courses under #6 were taken at another college, complete the Program Enrollment Prerequisite Enrollment (PEPE) Form, unofficial copies of the transcript from that college(s) will be needed.

You will upload your college transcripts and complete the **Program Enrollment Prerequisite Evaluation (PEPE) Request** by accessing this link <a href="https://www.swccd.edu/student-support/placement-and-prerequisites/prerequisites/index.aspx">https://www.swccd.edu/student-support/placement-and-prerequisites/prerequisites/index.aspx</a> under the Student Support, Placement and Prerequisites website.

- c) New students with US high school, will receive placements for English and math based on their high school GPA, courses taken in high school, and grades in high school courses. In order to do this, you will need to access the Southwestern College Math, English and ESL Placement Tool using this link: https://sso.comeyo.com/swccd/launch/2768
- d) New students who completed a high school equivalency like the GED will need to access the Southwestern College Math, English and ESL Placement Tool using this link: https://sso.comevo.com/swccd/launch/2768

# **STEP 2** – APPLICATION PROCESS:

Access the Police Academy website at <a href="www.swccd.edu/policeacademy">www.swccd.edu/policeacademy</a> and download the required documents to apply.

Use the **Checklist on page 3** of this document as a reference to make sure that you have all the required documents before emailing your application to the Police Academy. Incomplete applications will not move forward in the testing process.

### **STEP 3** - SUBMISSION:

Save all your documents listed on page 3 of the checklist as PDF files and submit via email to <a href="mailtoswcpoliceacademy@swccd.edu">swcpoliceacademy@swccd.edu</a>

### **STEP 4** - ENTRY TESTING:

If you meet all the requirements and your application is complete you will receive a confirmation email from the Police Academy Office. The following testing information with your scheduled test date will follow at a later date.

- **Physical Agility Test** P.O.S.T Work Sample Test Battery Pass/Fail 99-yard obstacle course, body drag (165 pounds), two-fence climbs (6' feet) solid wood wall and chain link fence, 500-yard run and one mile.
- **Oral Interview** Pass/Fail (Oral Interview appointments are scheduled, if you successfully pass the Physical Agility Test listed above)

All examinations are PASS/FAIL. Failure to pass or complete any portion of the application/testing process will result in your removal from consideration for placement in the academy.

### **STEP 5** - SELECTION:

Following successful completion of the physical agility test and oral interview, applicants will be notified via email if they have been ACCEPTED or DISQUALIFIED. If ACCEPTED, you will then move forward in the selection process and prepare for Day 1.

Additional forms will be provided by the Police Academy Office to begin a Department of Justice (DOJ) Clearance and a Medical Release Form, including other steps to take in purchasing your uniforms, materials, instructions on enrollment and registration.

### **STEP 6** - ORIENTATION 1 and ORIENTATION 2:

If selected, you will need to attend two mandatory orientations before starting on Day 1

# **Recruit Autobiography**

All applicants must submit an autobiography (ESSAY STYLE). SPECIFICALLY covering the areas mentioned below. Before you begin <u>writing</u> the autobiography it is important that you read and understand the instructions below.

The autobiography must be hand-written: Autobiographies that are <u>typed or printed via computer will</u> **not** be accepted.

- 1. Lined paper has been provided to you on the academy website <a href="www.swccd.edu/policeacademy">www.swccd.edu/policeacademy</a> titled Lined Paper Page (PDF), you will use the three-pages of lined paper to hand-write the essay.
- 2. The essay must be 2-3 pages (no less than 2 pages and must not exceed 3 pages.
- 3. Use **BLACK INK PEN** to hand write the essay.
- 4. All text must be in **CAPITAL LETTERING**

The essay will be reviewed for penmanship, completeness, neatness, organization, spelling, and grammar. The following should be covered in your autobiography:

#### **MARITAL STATUS**

Single? Married? If married, name of significant other, number of children, their ages, and names. List any other dependents.

#### **EDUCATION**

Name of high school, location, and highest grade attained. Did you letter in sports? Hold student body office, etc.?

Name of colleges, location, major(s), and number of units completed. Lettered in sports? What degrees, if any?

How many units of Criminal Justice /Administration of Justice completed? What were the courses?

#### MILITARY EXPERIENCE

Branch of service and dates. Highest rank held and rank of time of discharge. Duties while in the service and number of personnel supervised. Duty stations and locations. Awards received.

#### **EMPLOYMENT HISTORY**

Job titles held and type of work prior to law enforcement.

#### POLICE EXPERIENCE

What departments have you been employed by (including present), dates of employment, job assignments, and highest rank held?

#### **OUTSIDE INTERESTS**

List any hobbies, sports, fraternal organizations, civic service clubs, or other civic groups in which you have any interests.

#### OTHER (At the end of your autobiography answer the following questions):

Why do you want to enter law enforcement?

What do you expect to gain from this academy?

Why do you feel you will become a good officer?

Define, "Command Presence."
