2012-13 Statement of Work and 2013-14 Goals

The Strategic Planning Committee (SPC) was convened beginning in March 2013 to identify its scope of work; the committee's first task involved the development of a presentation to facilitate a review of Policy 1200 Institutional Mission, Vision and Values by the Shared Consultation Council (SCC) at its retreat in August 2013. Also, at the direction of the SCC, the SPC has begun reviewing the Educational Master Plan (EMP) to develop short-term action plans to address eminent needs as identified in the EMP and to cross reference those needs with our Strategic Plan, Strategic Priorities, Strategic Goals, and Strategic Objectives. In 2013-14 the SPC will recommend its short-term action plans to SCC, continue to review the Strategic Planning process, and facilitate the annual review of the Strategic Priorities by the college.
