

Dia de los Muertos



Dia de los Muertos (Day of the Dead) is cele-

brated on November 1st and 2nd. Dia de los Muertos remembers the people that have passed away. In Mexico people visit the cemetery where their loved ones are buried. They decorate gravesites with marigold flowers and candles. They bring toys for dead children and bottles of tequila to adults. They sit on picnic blankets next to gravesites, tell stories and eat the favorite food of their loved ones.

Mexican families build altars in their homes, write short poems called Calaveras dedicating them to the dead. They decorate their altars with papel picado, flowers, sugar skulls, religious items, food, pictures of the deceased and

pan de muerto.

Pan de muerto is a traditional bread that people eat on this day and it is only baked during this time of the year.

Papel Picado is a beautiful art piece or banner made out of

tissue paper in a variety of colors.

Child Development teacher Edna Marquez and Child Development Club will carry on the tradition to decorate our memorial. Edna and the Child Development Club will provide food and pamphlets that explain the meaning of Dia de los Muertos, and about the meaning of the San Ysidro tragedy.

HECSY Memorial represents each of the victims and how the community bonded together after the McDonalds' Tragedy.
