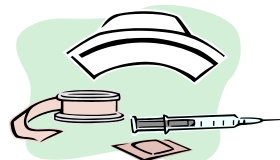
The print book collection at the HEC SY Library includes textbooks, EZ Readers, reference

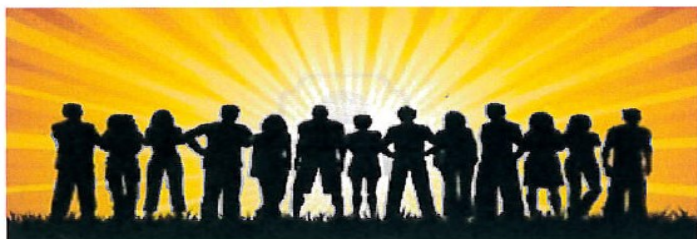
