

STANDARDS OF SCHOLARSHIP

References: Education Code Section 70902(b)(3);
Title 5 Sections 55020 et seq., 55030 et seq., and 55040 et seq.

Authority and responsibility for developing standards of scholarship is delegated to the Superintendent/President and the Academic Senate as described in Policy No. 2515 BP-Role and Scope of the Academic Senate.

The Superintendent/President shall work collaboratively with the Academic Senate on the development of procedures pertaining to standards of scholarship consistent with the provisions of Title 5 Sections 55020 et seq., 55030 et seq., 55040 et seq.

These procedures shall address: grading practices, academic record symbols, grade point average, credit by examination, academic and progress probation, academic and progress dismissal, academic renewal, course repetition, limits on remedial coursework, grade changes, and other areas of scholarship standards.

These procedures shall be described in the SWC Catalog and will be available on the SWC website.
