

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT PROPOSAL MAY 2017 ELECTIONS

ASO CONSTITUTION ARTICLE XI SECTION 1 AMENDMENTS AND REVISION:

"The ASO Constitution may be amended or revised by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the ASO members voting. All proposed amendments and revisions must be made public not less than ten (10) days before the regularly scheduled ASO election"

The ASO Senate proposes the following changes to the ASO Constitution:

ARTICLE V

LEGISLATIVE BRANCH

Section 1: Student Senate

Clause 2: Term of Office:

- 1. The term of office for Senators will be one (l) year, and will expire with the installation of the new Senators.
- 2. Vacancies in the Senate must be filled by a special election of the Senate to fill the remainder of the term.
- 3. No student will serve as a Senator At Large, Academic School Senator, Higher Education Senator, or Inter Club Council Senator, whether elected through ASO General Elections or In House Elections, for more than two terms.

Clause 3: Election of Senate Seats:

- 1. Twelve (12) <u>S</u>enate seats must be elected by the student body at large.
- Twelve (12) <u>Aat Llarge Ssenate seats must be elected in May and will be sworn into office in May.</u>
- 3. One Senate seat must be elected by the Inter Club Council.
- <u>43</u>. One senate seat must be elected filled by for each <u>A</u>academic <u>S</u>school, <u>& Higher</u> <u>Education C</u>eenter through In House Elections, and the Inter Club Council.
- 4. Guidelines for appointing division students to the senate are incorporated in the By-Laws of the ASO.

The proposed changes will do the following:

- Establish equal standards in the term limit of Senators, regardless of the specific demographic they represent;
- Establishes the formal process in which the Inter Club Council (ICC) Senator is elected
- Establishes that Academic School Senators and Higher Education Center Senators no longer require Dean recommendations to be elected to the ASO
