Types of Parking Permits

Student	\$40
Eligible Financial Aid BOGFW	\$20
Lot "O" and "G" (Chula Vista Campus only)	\$30
Motorcycle	\$20

Please note: Parking Permits are Non-Refundable.

The Student Parking Lot is located across the street northeast from HECSY. You must keep your <u>valid</u> <u>parking permit</u> displayed at all times. Please note that parking spaces around the building are reserved for faculty and staff only.

Parking Meters are for short-term visitors and are located in front of our main entrance.

Off Site Parking Not Allowed. Parking in adjacent business parking lots e.g. Yum, Yum Donuts, or the dirt lot across the street will most likely result in your vehicle being towed at your expense.

January 29 Spring 2018 Full-Term Semester Begins.

January 29-February 9

Add / Drop / class change period.

Last day to add classes on WebAdvisor. No late Adds accepted.

Last day to withdraw from a class without receiving a "W" grade. You

may add classes with an add code or withdraw from classes via

WebAdvisor.

Last day to withdraw from full semester classes and qualify for a full

refund of enrollment fees and non-resident tuition.

February 15 Last day to file a petition for Independent Study.

February 16-19 Holiday: Presidents' Day Weekend.

February 23 Last day to petition for Pass/No Pass credit.

March 1 Last day to petition for Graduation in Spring 2018

EOPS Timeline
