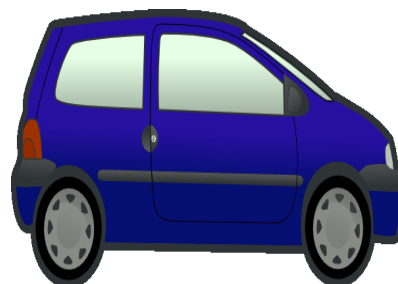
This is THE most important guide to help you know what services and resources are available for you at the HEC SY:

## Parking at HECSY

- ▶ Have your car registration and Credit/Debit card ready
- ▶ Print your temporary parking permit and place it on your dashboard.
- ▶ Permanent Parking permit will be mail to you within 5 to 10 days



### Types of Parking Permits

Please note that there will be **NO REFUNDS** once you purchase your parking permit.

**Student parking lot** is located across the street north-east from HECSY. It is important to have a valid and visible parking permit displayed at all times. Please note that parking spaces around the building are designated for faculty and staff only.

**Visitors Parking Spaces (painted green)** are for short-term visitors and are located in front of our main entrance.

**Off Site Parking**-Using parking spaces from businesses such as Yum, Yum Donuts, the U.S. Post Office, Smart & Final **is not permitted**. Your car can be towed and fines are up to \$400.

## Financial Aid

**California College Promise Grant Application** (formerly known as the BOGW) is now available through WebAdvisor.

The California Promise Grant will cover your fees for the 2018-2019 academic year: Summer 2018, Fall 2018, and Spring 2019.

You can still apply/renew FAFSA 2017/2018 & 2018/2019 applications. To avoid any delays with your award, please check your email and submit the requested paperwork required by the Financial Aid

department, otherwise your files will not be reviewed.
